FREESTYLE FRENZY AT THE 2006 FARMING SMALL AREAS EXPO

The Sydney Royal Roadshow brings the boys (and gals) to town!

Entertainment junkies will have the chance to meet and greet one of Australia's leading Freestyle MotoX riders – **Ben Jones**, and the Voice of McLeod's Daughters – **Rebecca Lavelle** at the 2006 Farming Small Areas Expo at Hawkesbury Showground, Richmond on 10 – 11 November 2006.

Rebecca Lavelle will be appearing on Saturday 11 November at 11am, 1pm and 3pm. Rebecca is an international country recording artist, and is also the voice behind the popular TV series, McLeod's Daughters.
