

- Gold** - Exhibits gaining 90.0 points and over;
- Silver** - Exhibits gaining 82.0 but less than 90.0 points;
- Bronze** - Exhibits gaining 74.0 but less than 82.0 points.

Gold Coast Tiger Prawns and Tathra Oysters steal the Show at Sydney Royal judging



15 April 2019

Gold Coast Marine Aquaculture and Tathra Oysters have dominated the Sydney Royal Aquaculture competition at its first-ever public judging at the Sydney Royal Easter Show on Friday 12.

Established in 2001, the Sydney Royal Aquaculture Competition judges the best of the best in Australian aquaculture. This year however the competition devoted a focus towards the growth of Australian Prawns and Oysters to build strength in the industry.

Chair of Judges, John Susman says the competition aims to support industry growth,

“Sydney Royal is the benchmark of quality for farmed prawns and Sydney Rock Oysters in Australia, and the competition aims to support the continued growth of the industry through its judging process,” Mr Susman said,

“With only a 5% variance between judges, this year’s judging has been one of the strongest field we have seen in many years”.

Gold Coast Marine Aquaculture is one of the largest Black Tiger Prawn farming companies in Australia and continues to be the benchmark of quality for farmed prawns and have continued their reign by taking home, ***Champion Prawn and the Champion Aquaculture Product Perpetual Trophy.***

Meanwhile Tathra Oysters has starred in the Sydney Rock Oysters section of the Sydney Royal Fine Food Show, winning ***Champion Sydney Rock Oyster.*** Tathra Oysters has been a consistent winner at the Sydney Royal Fine Food Show, winning several champions over the last 18 years, as well as the inaugural President’s Medal in 2006.

In another new addition to the competition, it is the first year the judging has been held live at the Sydney Royal Easter Show, allowing patrons to glimpse into the judging process for Sydney Rock Oyster and Australian grown prawn classes.


