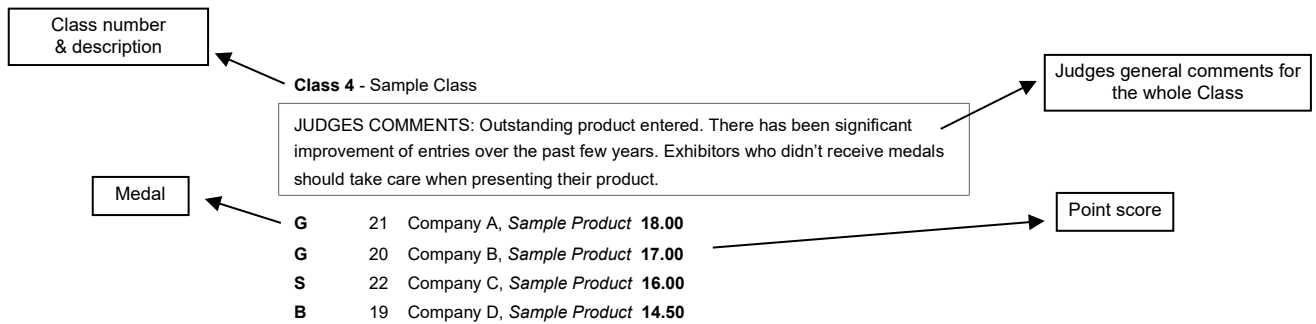
JUDGES' AWARDS
