Opening and Closing Times

The Show is open to the public from 9.00am each day and closes at 9pm. The Coca-Cola Carnival stays open until later.

Exhibitors will have access to Sydney Showground via Gate 9 from 6am. Between 8.30pm and 10.30pm, only pass holders can enter Sydney Showground. From 10.30pm, the site is locked down.

Only pass holders with accredited wristbands will be admitted by security.
