Entry Fees:	\$50 per exhibit (\$10/SP ring & \$15/AB ring)
Exhibitor Passes:	1-3 Exhibits = 2 entry passes 4+ Exhibits = 3 entry passes
Vetting:	7:00am - 8:15am Vaccination records are required. Veterinarian assessments are conducted by RAS prior to entry. All claws must be clipped.
Parking:	x1 Bump In & x1 Bump Out Pass per Exhibitor Parking is not provided by RAS or Cats Australia. We recommend booking parking early to avoid missing out. <a href="https://www.sydneyolympicpark.com.au/parking/">https://www.sydneyolympicpark.com.au/parking/</a>
Cages & Show Format:	The show will be conducted in full TICA format. Exhibitors will carry their cats from the home cage to the judging bay, please listen for when your cat's class is called. Judging bay cages are disinfected between each cat. The RAS will supply home cages; exhibitors must provide a cage base. Additional items may not be left in the cage and will be removed by the show committee. Cages measure approximately 560 mm × 510 mm.
Maximum Entries:	Due to the format of the show, Cats Australia will be limiting the number of entries. Please submit your entries or placeholders via TOES as soon as possible to secure your entries.
