Opening and Closing Times

The Show is open to the public from 8.30am each day and closes at 9pm. The Coca-Cola Carnival stays open until later.

Exhibitors will have access to Sydney Showground via Gate 9 from 6am. Between 8.30pm and 10.30pm, only pass holders can enter Sydney Showground. From 10.30pm, the site is locked down.

Only pass holders with accredited wristbands will be admitted by security.

CARCASE JUDGING METHOD

Carcase Judging

Carcases will be judged using an objective method developed specifically for this section, utilising both VIAscan and Meat Standards Australia technology.

Points will be awarded for:

- Meeting Woolworths Specifications - 40 points
- Yield of Saleable Meat - 30 points
- Eating Quality - 30 points

Woolworths Specifications

Carcases will receive higher scores if they are within the optimum range of specifications, including carcass weight.

MEDAL SYSTEM

The Sydney Royal Medal System is utilised in the Carcase section of the Sydney Royal Trade Hoof & Carcase Competition to better recognise those carcasses that meet the appropriate score levels to qualify for a Bronze, Silver or Gold medal.

The following points system is applied in the Sydney Royal Medal System for the Sydney Royal Trade Hoof & Carcase Competition.

VIRTUAL TASTE TEST COMPETITION

The Virtual Taste Test Score is calculated from the carcass's Meat Standards Australia (MSA) grading assessments. The score is calculated to reflect the predicted eating quality of a range of cuts from the carcass. To receive a Virtual Taste Test Score, carcasses need to have a pH of less than 5.70 and a minimum rib fat depth of 3mm.

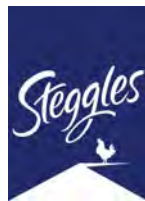
