#### (S923) - CHAMPION HEAVYWEIGHT CARCASE

Each first prize winner in Classes 11A, 12A, 13A and 14A will be eligible to compete. Prize \$750

#### (\$924) - PURCHASER OF THE CHAMPION HEAVYWEIGHT CARCASE

The E S Playfair Memorial Perpetual Trophy, presented by the RAS, to the purchaser of the Champion Heavyweight Carcase.

#### (\$925) - RESERVE CHAMPION HEAVYWEIGHT CARCASE

#### (\$930) - SUPREME CHAMPION EXHIBIT

To be awarded to the Exhibit obtaining the highest number of points across the Purebred Steer Classes 1 - 14 and the Purebred Carcase Classes 1A - 14A.

Points will be awarded for the three highest Awards in each Single Class only; points shall be allocated on the basis of 3, 2, 1.

Should there be fewer than 3 Awards in any one Single Class, the points shall be on the said basis in order of merit. (eg. If only 2 Entries in a Class, points will be allocated 3, 2).

In addition there shall be:

- 3 points for Champion
- 2 points for Reserve Champion
- 2 points for Grand Champion

## MOST SUCCESSFUL SCHOOL EXHIBITOR IN STEER CLASSES

The Eve Cullen Memorial Perpetual Trophy, for the Most Successful School Exhibitor in the Steer Classes, donated by Hugh and Brigid Robertson.

To be awarded to the School obtaining the highest number of points in the Purebred Steer Classes 1 - 14.

Points will be awarded for the five highest Awards in each Single Class only; points shall be allocated on the basis of 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Should there be fewer than 5 Awards in any one Single Class, the points shall be on the said basis in order of merit. (eg. If only 3 Entries in a Class, points will be allocated 5, 4, 3).

In addition there shall be:

- 3 points for Champion
- 2 points for Reserve Champion
- 2 points for Grand Champion

The Eve Cullen Memorial Perpetual Prize, for the Most Successful School Exhibitor in the Steer Classes. Prize money will be awarded, being interest derived from capital lodged with the RAS by Hugh and Brigid Robertson, to enable this prize to be competed for in perpetuity. Prize \$1000.

#### INTERBREED GROUP OF THREE STEERS

The Stan Hill Memorial Perpetual Trophy, for the Interbreed Group of Three Steers. Donated by Friends of the late Stan Hill, former Chairman of the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board.

#### CLASS 16 - INTERBREED GROUP OF THREE STEERS

No Entry Fee is required from the Exhibitor.

Prizes 1st ribbons and Medallions for each Exhibitor, 2nd ribbons, 3rd ribbons.

The conditions of the Competition are as follows:

- The Competition to be between breed teams of three steers entered in Classes 1A to 14A in the Purebred Steer & Carcase Competition.
- 2. Teams will be judged as carcases only.
- Entries must be submitted to the Administration Office by 7pm Thursday, 21 March 2024.
- 4. The Judge should note that steers may come from any of the Classes, and therefore evenness of the weights within the team should NOT be taken into account. Individual carcase points are scored out of 100, with a team maximum total of 300 points.
- 5. The winner of the Competition will be the team gaining the highest number of points in the carcase section.

#### CARCASE GROUP CLASSES

No Entry Fee is required from the Exhibitor.

Entry to these classes is not required at time of entry and Exhibitors are not required to nominate for these classes.

Any Exhibitor who meets the requirements and regulations, will automatically be eligible for these classes and entered.

#### **CLASS 17 - SCHOOL CARCASE GROUP**

Group of three School Carcases from Classes 1A to 14A.

Exhibited by a School only. Animals owned or Exhibited in partnership are not eligible for the School Carcase Group.

All animals to be prepared by the School, no less than two months prior to weighing and scanning.

#### CLASS 18 - BREEDERS CARCASE GROUP

Group of three Carcases from Classes 1A to 14A.

All animals to be bred by the one breeder and Exhibited by the one Exhibitor (Breeder and Exhibitor not necessarily the same entity/name).

## HERDSMAN'S BEST MAINTAINED TEAM COMPETITION

This Competition is defined as follows:

- (a) The winner will be the best displayed and maintained team.
- (b) The overall prize winners will receive first, second and third prize ribbons.

The points will be allocated in the following manner:


