

**2026 Sydney Royal Easter Show
Breed Display Day – Monday 13 April 2026**

The Royal Agricultural Society of NSW ('RAS') would like to invite you to apply for a breed stall at the Sydney Royal Easter Show. The breed stall day will be held on **Monday 13th April 2026** for one day only. Each stall is required to be active between 9.00am and 5.00pm and is a good chance to promote your breed and club, as well as educating the public about responsible pet ownership.

Breed Stalls will be located at the Howie Pavilion and application is free! You will be provided benching modules (for a maximum of 3-4 dogs for giant or large breeds), one-day entry passes for those attending, limited parking (based on numbers and allocation) and trestle tables. Fencing can be removed if preferred. Stalls must be set up no later than 8.30am as the Pavilion opens at 9.00am to the general public. Locations will be pre allocated and you will be informed of your location prior to attending.

When filling in the form please ensure you advise the size of your breed as there may be a limit on the number of dogs we can accommodate.

The RAS will be supporting the 'Breed Stall Day' during the 2026 ADVANCE™ Sydney Royal Dog Show with \$100.00 prize money thanks to Dogs NSW for the following;

- Most Informative Breed Stand
- Best Breed Display

The Companion Animals Committee requests that you provide the office staff with a sample of any literature that will be available to the public at the stand to ensure there is no conflict of interest with our existing sponsorship contracts. Please also note that retail sales are not permitted, the space is intended for educational and display purposes only.

- ❑ **PLEASE NOTE THIS IS AN EXPRESSION OF INTEREST.** Applicants will not be confirmed until an agreement has been returned and signed.
- ❑ Clubs are encouraged to bring along dogs and puppies (over 3 months) but they must have current vaccination papers and be registered with Dogs NSW or another recognised controlling body.
- ❑ Stalls must be staffed during the hours that the pavilion is opened to the public. The Royal Agricultural Society of NSW will not take responsibility for any stall left unattended.
- ❑ Breed Clubs must provide their own material and equipment for the stall (apart from what is outlined above). Exhibitors are responsible for the safety and security of all their belongings in the space used and for the duration of that use. The RAS does not accept liability for any damage or loss of property which may occur.
