SARAH CROWE | WINEMAKER | YARRA YERING

After studying and working in Horticulture Sarah began her wine career with vineyard work in the Hunter Valley and within three years had become Brokenwood's Assistant Winemaker. Building on her experience Sarah completed International harvests in both Oregon and the Rhone Valley. Wine Show Judging has been part of Sarah's calendar year since 2007 including both regional and capital city wine shows. Sarah's first role as Chair of Judges was at the Hunter Valley Wine Show in 2018 and she has since added Chair of Judges at the Adelaide Hills Wine Show and Gippsland Wine Show. 2022 will be Sarah's first year as Chair of the Sydney Royal Wine Show.

After 12 years in the Hunter Valley Sarah made the move to the Yarra Valley joining the team at Yarra Yering in 2013 to focus on one single iconic vineyard site. The vineyard is central to wine quality and Sarah considers the Yarra Yering vineyard to be the best she has ever worked with. Now in the role of Winemaker and General Manager, Sarah hopes to continue to build on the reputation started in 1969 with the first vineyard plantings at Yarra Yering.

Since arriving at Yarra Yering Sarah has been named both Gourmet Traveller WINE and James Halliday's Winemaker of the Year. Yarra Yering has received James Halliday's Winery of the Year and Wine of the Year, as well as The Real Review's Winery of the Year.

The Sydney Royal Wine Show was thrilled to welcome esteemed international judge, Clara Rubin, to its expert judging panel this year, with Clara travelling all the way from the United Kingdom to offer her unique insight and knowledge.

With over ten years of experience, Clara is an IWSC judge and certified WSET Educator who has made significant contributions to the wine community. Most notably, she developed Veraison, a ground-breaking wine service education tool that has provided industry-leading training to over 4000 people in the wine service industry.

In 2018, Clara's dedication to advancing wine education earned her recognition and respect from professionals worldwide after she won the prestigious Julian Brind Award for Outstanding Achievement in the Wine industry from the International Wine & Spirit Competition (IWSC).



Joining forces with 31 esteemed experts, Rubin helped form a panel of judges who represent the pinnacle of wine expertise in Australia and examined some of the 1,700 wines entered into the prestigious Sydney Royal Wine Show. In addition to offering her insight and feedback to exhibitors, Rubin also selected her favourite exhibit, named The International Guest Judge Annual Prize.

Her passion for wine, coupled with her expertise in the industry and international perspective, has undoubtedly enriched the judging process and made her an invaluable addition to the team and to our exhibitors.





SNIFF, SIP AND SAVOUR

SPARKLING	green apples, brioche, oyster shell and citrus crisp finish
RIESLING	floral, green apple, minerality and refreshing lime
SAUVIGNON BLANC	green capsicum, passionfruit and herbal
PINOT GRIS OR PINOT GRIGIO	poached pears/apples and bakers spices with crispness
SEMILLON	lemon, lime and oyster shell minerals
CHARDONNAY	flinty, crisp pink lady apples, stone fruit and vanilla
OTHER WHITE VARIETAL WINES	diversity of herbal, melon and citrus tang
WHITE BLENDS	combinations of green, citrus and tropical fruit
ROSÉ	red berries, perfumed savoury ripe fruit and lemon
PINOT NOIR	red berries, earthy mushroom and silky tannins
MERLOT	ripe spicy plum, blueberries and chocolate
OTHER RED VARIETALS	red and black fruit jam, spicy vanillin/smoky oak
RED BLENDS	red and black berries/jam, black spices, balanced softness, rounded aged caramel oak
INNOVATION WINES	pushing boundaries of perception – enjoy them for what they are
SHIRAZ	white or black pepper, ripe plums/prunes and spicy oak
SHIRAZ DOMINANT BLENDS	spicy plum jam, hits of blackberries and elegant firm tannins.
CABERNET SAUVIGNON	blackcurrant, leafy, dark chocolate and firm structured tannins
SWEET WHITE WINE	Intense marmalade, apricot jam and pineapple freshness
FORTIFIED WINE	layered intensity of liquorice/golden syrup/plum pudding, upon layers of dried fig, raisins and the warmth of aged brandy spirit
BRANDY	roasted almond, 85% cocoa, mandarin rind and toffee oak

HOW TO MAKE THE MOST OF THE GRAPE, GRAIN & GRAZE FESTIVAL

How do I make my way around the room?

The room is split into red and white wine tasting areas. Wines are grouped by varietal. Beer & Cider can be found outside in the beer garden alongside a full service bar, the Sydney Royal Marketplace and Bianco.

Where are the Trophy Wines?

The trophy wines are located in the Trophy Room, which is located as indicated on the map to the right hand side of the room.

What did a wine score?

You can view the results catalogue online at rasnsw.com.au/sydneyroyal. Results are listed by Class order. The score and any medals the wine won will be noted.

Why is there a maximum pour size?

There are many wines available to taste at the event and we want to ensure that our guests have the opportunity to experience several wines.

Why has some of the wine run out?

Unfortunately, we don't have enough wine for everyone to have a taste of everything and there may be wines that are more popular with guests than others are.

Judge Masterclasses

Gain insights on tasting and selecting quality wine or beer from Judges at a masterclass. Tickets are essential but if you don't have one and would like to join in, follow the map to either of the class locations and ask if there is an available spot when you arrive.

Why isn't the white wine chilled?

The white wine is not chilled so that you can experience and taste the wine as the judges do in the judging process. Chilling wine dulls the taste and flavour, so serving it at room temperature allows all aromas to be at their peak.

Where can I taste beer & Cider?

Beer & Cider tastings are available from the bar inside the beer garden.

I'm hungry!

The cheese & charcuterie grazing tables within the pavilion are included in the price of your ticket. Bianco is offering pasta for purchase outside in the beer garden.

Why can't I take my bag in to the event?

For the safety and comfort of all guests, we have a cloakroom available for large bags to be held on your behalf.

Finally, please remember to put safety first and don't drink and drive.






