SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

1. Exhibitors who are occupants of bars in Wine Annex to pay a fine of £3 3s. for right to sell.
2. Competitive and non-competitive exhibitors in Wine Annex or Pavilion who may give away or in any way dispose of wines as samples to pay a fee of £3 3s.
3. Exhibitors must mark on the bottles, in plain figures, the year of the Exhibition (1899), and the number of the Class or Classes in which each sample is entered. The bottles must be wine bottles (reputed quarts), and labelled with business labels or the name of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors must also mark their names and addresses on their cases or hampers.
4. Exhibitors may enter three samples of any one Class. The name, character, and vintage of the wines must be stated on the Entry Forms.
5. All wines exhibited must be the produce of the grape, and be free from impurities or adulterations.
6. The Council reserve the right of having any wine analysed by an expert to be selected by them, and his decision shall be final.
7. Wines, &c., addressed to the Secretary of the Society, must be lodged at the office of the Society, Hunter-street, Sydney,

On or before 7th March, 1899

(one month before the Show). They will be judged a fortnight before the Show opens.

NOTE.—Unless freight and carriage to Exhibition Building have been fully paid, delivery will not be taken by the Society.

8. In the 1897 Vintage Wines the three bottles comprised in the entry will become the property of the Society, and in the other Classes one half the number of bottles will become the property of the Society, for purposes of adjudication, and for future reference and comparison. The remaining half will be sent out to the Show Grounds, for sale as the property of the exhibitors, who may remove from the Grounds any left over within one week after the Show closes; any remaining after that time to become the property of the Society.

9. The Society will make special arrangements for the wines being retailed to the public in the Wine Kiosk on the Show Grounds, subject to Special Rules and Regulations.

10. Exhibitors shall, at the time of delivery at the office, hand to the Secretary Certificates signed by them, giving the locality where the Wines are grown, the age, color, whether of light character or full-bodied, or sweet, and any other information relative to the character of the Wines that may assist the Stewards in classifying them.
