REGULATIONS.

1. Exhibitors will be allowed only one entry in any one class.
2. Only female exhibitors (amateurs) are allowed to compete in this Section. Teachers in the class of work exhibited, or women who do similar work as a means of livelihood or who conduct a business establishment in which such work is sold are not regarded as amateurs. Those attending classes for dressmaking, needlework, cookery, arts and crafts, will be eligible to exhibit. Exhibitors may be called upon to sign a statutory declaration to the effect that they have not received any money for the class of work exhibited.
3. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor, and must not have been previously exhibited.
4. Exhibits that have been washed will be disqualified.
5. No portion of a collection may compete as a single exhibit.
6. Unless otherwise stated, no exhibit to consist of more than six specimens.
7. Name or age of exhibitor will not be allowed on any exhibit.
8. No factory made goods will be allowed.
9. Each exhibit to consist of one article only, unless otherwise specified.
10. An exhibit cannot be entered in more than one class.
11. Non-competitive exhibits will not be received.
12. Except where otherwise mentioned, articles may have seams and hems machine sewn, but all decorative work must be handwork.
13. "For Sale" cards or Notices will not be permitted on exhibits.
14. Special exhibit numbers will be issued at time of making entry, and must be firmly fixed to every exhibit. Duplicate numbers must be attached to all articles making up a collection.
15. All exhibits entered and submitted shall be inspected by a selection committee, appointed by the Society. The Committee shall have power to reject and debar from exhibition any exhibit which, in their opinion, is not up to standard. Only exhibits approved by the Committee shall be placed before the judges.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS.

All exhibits (Cookery excepted) unclaimed by Friday, 29th March, will be despatched by Rail or Parcel post.
