Championship Cat Exhibition

Held under the rules and regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W. All Cats must be registered with a recognised governing body.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

1. A cat may be entered in more than one class subject to the schedule as classified.
2. All cats exhibited at the Show must be fed by the exhibitor.
3. Prize money will be paid according to the Judge's awards, and the number of cats exhibited.
4. All cats must be at the Dog Pavilion at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, 15th April for examination by the Official Veterinary Surgeon of the Society. The examination will take place inside the pavilion; cats will not be examined outside the pavilion. If approved, the cat must be at once benched. Cats will not be benched or judged before having been so examined. No person, except the owner or his representative, will be allowed in the pavilion until after the cats have been examined and benched. Any cat showing symptoms of any disease must be removed from the Show-ground at once.
5. A challenge certificate may be awarded in each sex in Persians and Siamese classes if recommended by the Judge.
6. No cat shall be removed from the Show building between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., unless a veterinary certificate be produced stating that the cat is not fit to remain on the bench.
7. Delivery of cats will commence at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, 15th April.
8. No cat shall be removed from the pavilion unless a "Pass-out" is obtained from the Superintendent.
9. All cats must be judged in their cages, and prior to the judging there shall be no interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing objects, such as coloured blankets, sanitary tins, etc. Plain white blankets will be allowed. The Judge will be instructed to pass any pen so distinguished.
10. No cat or kittens shall be removed from their cages during the Show for any purpose whatsoever without the authority of the Superintendent.
11. The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or mis-delivery of Live-stock or other Exhibits at the Society's Exhibition, or any damage thereto.
12. The age of all cats will be the actual age on the day of competition.
13. All Exhibits sold at the Exhibition, or prior to their return to the owner's residence, will be subject to a commission of 1 per cent. if sold by auction, or 5 per cent. if sold privately, on gross amount of sale.

PENALTY—NON-EXHIBITION OF CATS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of cats which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show benches, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10s. for each and every entry of cat not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the cat or cats or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by the explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by the cat or cats becoming ineligible for the class in which they have been entered or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

Siamese cats can only be entered in Classes 71, 72, and 73.
