PENALTY-MON-EXHIBITION OF PIGS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing annecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10s, for each and every entry of pigs not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorized agent he lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal eranimals; or (3) contagious or infactious disease (confirmed by an explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered, or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

Prises. In addition to the cash prises specified in each class, ribbons will be presented.

Age of all pigs to be calculated from the birth date shown in the litter registration in the herd book up ta

Full particulars must be stated on the entry form of age, pedigree, herd book number if fixed. In the case where no number is fixed, proof of acceptance for herd book must be produced, except where otherwise specified.

No pig shall be entered for a class for which it is not eligible on account of age. Exhibitors may be disquali-fied and debarred from further competition for any breach of this by-law.

No hear over 16 months old which has not sired a litter of live plgs shall be eligible to compete.

No pig over 16 months of age shall be eligible to compete unless the date of farrow of the last progeny produced is shown on the entry form.

Boars over 15 months old must have had their tusks cut down at least three weeks prior to judging day.

All pigs exhibited with a sow shall be her own progeny, and not exceeding 10 weeks old at the time of the

No anw over two years old which has not produced a litter of live pigs shall be eligible to compete in any of

Any sow, entered in a sow and litter class, which has not farrowed at the time of judging may compete in a dry class or vice versa. The exhibitor must advise the Secretary as early as possible to enable the transfer to be effected before the time of judging.

All pigs exhibited in group classes must be paraded and judged as a group, and not on their awards in indivi-

First and second prize sows in litter classes may compete individually for championship prizes.

Any animal in the Pig Classes found to be artificially coloured will be disqualified

Exhibitors will not be allowed more than three entries in any one class.

Exhibitors from other States should obtain from the Stock Branches of their own State and N.S.W. a "permit to travel' before arranging to despatch the pige to Sydney.

All pigs shall be fed and attended to by the exhibitor who shall be responsible for the cleanliness and proper condition of the sties while the pigs remain on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, and shall be subject to the control of the Superintendent of the section appointed by the Society.

In the event of any pig being unfed, or any sty being in improper condition at any time while the pig remains on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, the officials of the Society shall feed and attend to the pig, and the cost of such feed and attendance shall be borne by the exhibitor of the pig.

Any exhibitor who may neglect to feed and properly attend to all pigs exhibited by him during the period which they remain in the sties, either before or after the pig sales, shall be liable to disqualification after enquiry by the Council.

No pig shall be removed from its numbered pen without the sanction of the Superintendent.

Each exhibitor or his representative will be allowed to get in the pen and show his pig to the Judge, and must remain in the pen until the Judge has finished with that exhibit.

The Superintendent will take delivery on Showground of all exhibits, and at close of Show will deliver same and issue pass-out checks and return railway certificates.

REGULATIONS APPERTAINING TO BRUCELLOSIS OF SWIND

The New South Wales Government Regulations require that no boar or sow shall leave the Cumberland and Picton Pastures Protection Districts without a permit and unless from a holding which has been declared free of the

To enable the Sydney Showground to be declared a place free from Brucellosis of Swine and for pigs to be moved therefrom on permit without testing, the Chief of the Animal Industry. Department of Agriculture, M.S.W. directed the undermentioned regulation to govern the acceptance of entries for the Pig Section at the 1941 Royal

A pig shall not be admitted to the Sydney Showground for exhibition at the 1941 Heyel Empire Show until the Society is furnished by the exhibitor with a certificate received by him from a Government Veterinary Officer of the State of origin of the pig, to the effect that each pig to be exhibited had been twice subjected to the agglutination test for Srucellesis with negative results, with an interval of 30 days between the tests, and the pigs have been maintained in isolation from the date on which the first blood sample for testing had been taken; or failing which a certificate from a New South Wales Government Veterinary Officer to the effect that the pig is from a holding which has been declared by the Chief Veterinary Officer of New South Wales, to be free from the disease following the application of the agglutins of test.

BESPONSIBILITY.

42 DAMAGE THROUGH EXHIBITS.—The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibit, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society harmless and indemnity it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident.

43. DAMAGE TO EXHIBITS.—The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or other exhibits at the Society's Exhibition, or any damage thereto.

44. LOSS BY DISEASE.—The signing of the certificate of entry of any animal will be taken as a guarantee that the animal specified is free from all disease, so far as it is known to the owner. In case of infectious disease being spread through or by any exhibit the exhibitor shall be held responsible.

Pigs are to be weighed alive on Thursday, 3rd April, and the weights will be handed to the judge, who shall commence his live judging at 10.30 a.m., the same day. At the conclusion of the live judging two pigs from each pen will be sent to the State Abattoirs, Homebush Bay, Sydney, where they will be killed and dressed. The two pigs selected for slaughter shall be the heaviest and lighest exhibit comprising the pen. The lightest exhibit will be sectioned to ascertain the required measurements. One carcase shall remain intact whilst the other will be cut into sides, one of which shall be cut in half at the last rib. The carcases will then be judged in accordance with the abovementioned points. At the conclusion of the carease judging the first, second, and third prize winning careases will be hung in the Metropolitan Meat Industry Commissioner's refrigerated cabinet at the Royal Agricultural Society's Show this year, where they will remain until the termination of the Show. Delivery of unselected careases shall be made immediately after judging.
