ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS.

All Poultry and Pigeons must be penned before 9 p.m. on Monday, 7th April, Canaries and Cage Birds by 9 p.m. on Thursday, 10th April. Special labels are issued to exhibitors of Poultry to be attached to their crates, baskets, etc. They are requested to attach same to their crates etc., and mark thereon the catalogue numbers of the birds contained therein. By complying with this, exhibitors will have their birds returned in the same crates as despatched in and avoid wrong birds being placed in the crates. No bird will be received at the pavilion unless the tag supplied to each exhibitor with the pen number slip is securely fastened to one of the bird's legs. Birds are not to be removed from the Show before 9 p.m. on Tuesday, 15th April. Exhibits will be delivered on demand over barriers only at entrance to building. No exhibitor will be allowed inside the barrier while exhibits are being delivered. The return of exhibits by rail will commence on the morning of Wednesday, 16th April, and continue until completed.

ATTENTION IS DIRECTED TO BY-LAW 43, DAMAGE TO EXHIBITS.

The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or other exhibits at the Society's Exhibition or any damage thereto.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

Entries will only be accepted on the express condition that the following regulations shall be applicable:—

- No entry will be received from any person disqualified by this Society or any recognised Club or Society, during the period of such disqualification provided that notice has been received of the disqualification, and the same has been confirmed by the Council. Should any such entry be accidentally accepted, it shall, whenever discovered, be deemed void, and the entry fee returned.
- No exhibit shall be entered by or in the name of any person who is disqualified, or which is not at the time of the entry the bona fide property of the exhibitor. No sale for a limited period or borrowing will be allowed. In the case of partnerships or joint ownerships, the names of all such partners or owners must be stated, and each of such owners shall be equally liable under all the rules and regulations of this Society.
- No exhibit entered in a wrong class will be allowed to compete, and the entry fee in respect of such exhibit will be forfeited.
- The Council reserves the right of refusing or cancelling any entry without giving any reason for so doing.
- The decision of the Judges shall be accepted as final.
- No trimming, plucking, dyeing of feathers, legs, or any other fraudulent practice will be allowed, and every exhibitor will be deemed to be, and will be held responsible for the condition in which his exhibit appears in the pen.
- All protests will be considered by the Council as soon as possible after the judgment, and their decision shall be final for this Show.
- Whenever any exhibit has been disqualified the Council may also disqualify the exhibitor thereof from exhibiting at future Shows of this Society and may declare forfeited all prizes awarded to him.
- Should any exhibit which has been awarded a prize be disqualified, the next in order of merit on the Judge's award card shall not necessarily be entitled to the prize, but the matter shall be determined by the Council.
- The Society will not receive the proceeds of sales of birds or take any responsibility in connection with the same except in Table Poultry Classes, where any pen of birds exhibited may be claimed from the exhibitor for £2 2s., in which case a written claim must be lodged with the Superintendent, together with the above amount, before noon on the day following judging. In the event of more than one claim being lodged for any one pen the respective claimants will be invited to tender for that exhibit.
- All exhibits sold at the Exhibition, or prior to their return to the owner's residence, will be subject to a commission of 2½ per cent. on the gross amount of sale.

POULTRY.

All cockerels and pullets must be under 12 months old.
 All Poultry must be penned by 9 p.m. on Monday, 7th April.
 No bird will be admitted to the ground after Monday, 7th April, and no person will be admitted into the building on Tuesday, 8th April, till after the judging is over.
 Judging to start at 9 a.m. on TUESDAY, 8th April.
 The pavilion will be open to the public daily, after judging, and from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and from 7 o'clock to 10 o'clock on the evenings of Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, Monday, and Tuesday, 9th, 10th, 12th, 14th, and 15th April; and also from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Good Friday, 11th April.
 No exhibit may be removed until after 9 p.m. on Tuesday 15th April. The return of birds by rail will commence on the morning of Wednesday, 16th April, and continue until completed.

PENALTY—NON-EXHIBITION OF POULTRY.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of poultry which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show pens, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10/- for each and every entry of poultry not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the bird or birds; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by the explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by the bird or birds becoming ineligible for the class in which they have been entered or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

A Royal Champion Card may be awarded to each sex of each variety where there are four classes. Where there are two classes only in the variety, both sexes shall compete for the Royal Champion Card.

In classes up to 10 entries, First, Second, and Third prizes shall only be awarded. In classes of 11 and not more than 20 entries, First, Second, and Third prizes, in addition to one Very Highly Commended, one Highly Commended, and one Commended card only may be awarded. In classes of over 20 entries, First, Second, and Third Prizes, in addition to two Very Highly Commended, two Highly Commended, and one Commended card only may be awarded.

The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

SECTION 7—SUB-SECTION D.

PENALTY—NON-EXHIBITION OF CAGE BIRDS.

AUSTRALIAN AND FOREIGN CAGE BIRDS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of birds which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show pens, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10/- for each and every entry of cage birds not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of exhibition to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the bird or birds; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by an explanatory certificate); or (3) by the bird or birds becoming ineligible for the class in which they have been entered or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

CAGES.

All exhibits must be shown in standard show cages not smaller than 10½ inches long, 10 inches high, 4½ inches wide, outside measurements; straight or bow front optional, painted pale blue inside and black all over outside, perches half inch extended from back of cage to wire front.

SPECIAL PRIZES.

A Royal Empire Show Medallion will be awarded for the best Budgerigar.

A Royal Empire Show Medallion will be awarded for the best Cage Bird.

A Royal Champion Card may be awarded to the best Australian Finch, Foreign Finch, and Budgerigar.

In classes up to 10 entries, First, Second, and Third prizes only shall be awarded. In classes of 11 and not more than 20 entries, First, Second and Third prizes, in addition to one Very Highly Commended, one Highly Commended and one Commended card only may be awarded. In classes of over 20 entries, First, Second, and Third prizes, in addition to two Very Highly Commended two Highly Commended, and one Commended card only may be awarded.

CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW.

Held under the Rules and Regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of New South Wales.
 SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

- All dogs must be registered in this Society's Canine Register and must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. Fee, 2s. Dogs registered with the Kennel Club (England) or a recognised interstate canine governing body must be re-registered without a fee.
- A dog may be entered in more than one class, subject to the schedule as classified.
- Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his or her engagement, or where two or more judges appointed to make an award fail to agree, the Society shall have the right of appointing another judge without reference to the exhibitors.
- Prize money will be paid on the Judge's awards, in accordance with the number of entries in each class.
- All dogs must be at the Dog Pavilion at 8.45 a.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, or Monday, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, and 14th April (in accordance with judging groups). The examination of dogs by the Official Veterinary Surgeon of the Society will take place at the pavilion. If approved, the dog must be at once benched. Dogs will not be benched or judged before having been so examined. No person, except the owner or his representative, will be allowed in the pavilion until after the dogs have been examined and benched. Any dog showing symptoms of any disease must be removed from the Showground at once.
- All dogs must be brought to the Show fastened with a suitable chain and collar.
- A challenge and reserve challenge certificate may be awarded in any breed if recommended by the Judge.
- No prize cards or other notices may be placed over the benches except the official prize cards for the current Show. Bench numbers shall not be changed from one pen to another, unless authorised by the Superintendent.
- Dogs must not be removed from the Show building between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily, unless a Veterinary Certificate be produced stating that the dog is not fit to remain on the bench, or for the purpose of being judged, or for exercise, for which permission must be obtained from a Steward.
- If a dog is not on its bench when required for judging, the Society will not be responsible for its absence.
- Exhibitors must not interfere in any way with the benching as erected, and in particular the partitions between one pen and another must not be removed under any circumstances.
- Only dogs on exhibition for the particular day of judging will be permitted to be benched. This regulation will not apply to prize winners of previous sessions.
- Dogs absent from any class for which they have been entered except in the case of their being ineligible for same shall not be judged in subsequent classes.
- All protests must be lodged (in writing) by noon on the day following the judging, such protests to be placed in a box provided for that purpose in the office of the Secretary on the Showground. The sum of £1 1s. must accompany each protest, and this sum may be forfeited if the protest is considered frivolous. Protests shall be heard by the committees of the sections in which the protests occur, and the recommendations of the committees shall be reported to the Council, whose decision on protests shall be final.
- Delivery of Dogs—The pavilion will be closed to the public at 6 p.m. daily, when the delivery of dogs will commence.
- All exhibits sold at the exhibition, or prior to their return to the owner's residence, will be subject to a commission of 1 per cent. if sold by auction, or 5 per cent. if sold privately, on gross amount of sale.

Note: Should an exhibitor wish to have his or her dogs benched alongside those of another exhibitor of the same breed, notification accordingly must be given on the entry form.

SUBSTITUTE JUDGE.

The Council reserves the right to substitute a judge when deemed necessary.

RESERVE AWARD.

For the purpose of the Society's records judges will make a Reserve Award when deciding Special Prizes.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES.

(As referred to in the following pages).

The undermentioned classes are limited to any variety of breed therein provided for.

The first day of the Show means the first day on which the breed is exhibited.

A Minor Puppy Class is one confined to dogs not exceeding nine months of age prior to midnight of the first day of the Show.
