SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

- All classes are open for competition to wine growers and wine merchants.
- A wine merchant shall mean any person, association, or company buying wine.
- A wine grower shall mean any wine grower owning or occupying a vineyard, and manufacturing wine from grapes grown in such vineyard, or from grapes purchased for the purpose of wine-making.
- Exhibitors may either be members or non-members of the Society. Entry fee: Members, 5s; non-members, 10s.
- Exhibitors will be allowed up to four entries in any one class. Each wine sample to consist of four quart (reputed) bottles. Three quart (reputed) bottles are to be supplied for Brandy and Vermouth. Exhibitors entering the same wine in more than one class must supply the full number of sample bottles for each entry.
- All wines will be judged on points.
- No exhibitor will be awarded more than two prizes in any one class. Where an exhibitor has more than two entries in a class, only the exhibit securing the highest number of points shall be considered for the prizes. The succeeding prizes will be awarded in a similar manner among the remaining exhibitors in that class.
- The judge may award prizes on the basis of First, Second, Third, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended, but prize money will only be allocated for first and second awards.
- Entries must be made on forms supplied by the Society for that purpose. Exhibitors must state on the entry form the class to be competed for, the distinguishing mark on the exhibits, character and vintage of the wine, and the quantity in stock.
- No person will be allowed to inspect an entry form, after reception by the Secretary, until the Judges' awards have been made public.
- After the close of entries, no person will be permitted access to the exhibits, except the Judges, Secretary, and Staff, until the awards have been made.
- Exhibits are to bear the labels supplied by the Society for that purpose, and must show:—
(a) The year of the Competition (1941).
(b) The number of the class.
(c) Where more than one entry, the distinguishing mark of the entry to conform to the entry form.
(d) The year of vintage.
- (N.B.—Bottles must not be labelled with business labels. Branded bottles and corks are permissible.)
- Brandy entries when drawn from Bond to be sealed by Customs officer.
- Sparkling Wines not to be of older vintage than 10 years from date of exhibition, and to represent wines which can be purchased on the market.
- Exhibits to be delivered to the Secretary of the Society at the Sydney Showground in cases properly marked to show Exhibitor's name, not later than Saturday, 15th March, 1941.
- In all classes the wine in stock as stated on the entry form may be inspected and checked by a representative of the Society or its nominee. Each exhibitor must supply the Society with a sealed envelope containing the record of any sale made subsequent to their entries being lodged, provided such sale has reduced the stipulated quantity below the minimum.
- All exhibits to become the property of the Society. In disposing of the wine it shall be sold by public auction, and the proceeds of such to be donated to charity as selected by the Society.
- Exhibits must represent stocks as set out on entry form, and be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.

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Sec. 6—WINES (Continued).

- All wine exhibits must be the sole produce of Australian grapes and free from any foreign substance. The Society reserves the right to have any exhibit inspected and/or analysed by one or more persons appointed for that purpose.
- All exhibits must conform to the respective Wine or Food Acts of the States of New South Wales, Victoria, and South Australia.
- No protest will be entertained if not made within three days after the close of the last judging day of the Wine Section.
- No entry will be received from any person or persons disqualified by this or any other similar Society during the period of such disqualification. Should any such entry be accepted, it shall, when discovered, be deemed void and the entry fee and exhibit shall be forfeited to the Society.
- Immediately after the closing date of entries a draw will be made for the selection of three exhibitors from whose entries a further draw will be made to enable one sample to be selected from each exhibitor. An official of the Society shall make an inspection of the quantity of such wine in accordance with the entry form, and his report will be later considered by the Committee.
- All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the Judges appointed by the Society as to the merits of their exhibits.
- No exhibitor will be permitted to occupy the position of Judge or Steward or become in any way identified with the judging or handling of the exhibits.
- Any competitor making improper use of prizes won in the Wine Section for advertising purposes will be subject to disqualification.

INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES.

- Judging of all wine exhibits to be on the following scale of points:—
Condition and colour 5 points
Bouquet 10 points
Flavour 10 points
- The Judges shall have power to disqualify or disqualify, or being not eligible for judging, any exhibit which, in their opinion, does not comply with the regulations in every respect and such disqualification or disqualification shall be accepted as final. The Judges shall have power to call in one or more persons, not being exhibitors, for consultative or advisory purposes.
- In the event of there being no competition in a class, Judges may award a prize or not, as they think fit. Prizes may be withheld in any class where exhibits are considered unworthy.
- Where, in the opinion of the Judge, a wine is not in accordance with the conditions, he shall, before making the award in the class, refer the matter to the Committee for enquiry.
- The Judges have the discretionary power, in the event of an exhibitor wrongly classifying his exhibit, to place it in its proper class.

ENTRIES AND EXHIBITS.

All entries must be lodged with the Secretary, Endeavour House, 33 Macquarie Place, Sydney, on or before Monday, 3rd March, 1941, and exhibits at the Wine Kiosk on Showground not later than Saturday, 15th March, 1941.

All sections open to growers and merchants.

The quantity in stock must (unless otherwise specified) be not less than the following, viz:—Vintage, 1940, 300 gallons; Vintage, 1939, 300 gallons; Vintage, 1938, 100 gallons; Vintage, 1937, or older, 50 gallons.

An exhibition sample shall consist of four quart (reputed) bottles, except for Brandy and Vermouth, for which three quart (reputed) bottles must be supplied.
