#### SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

- 1 All classes are open for competition to wine growers and wine merchants.
- 2. A wine merchant shall mean any person, association, or company buying wine.
- S. A wine grower shall mean any wine grower owning or occupying a vineyard, and manufacturing wine from grapes grown in such vineyard, or from grapes purchased for the purpose of wine-making.
- 4. Exhibitors may either be members or non-members of the Society. Entry fee: Members, 5s; non-members,
- S. Exhibitors will be allowed up to four entries in any one class. Each wine sample to consist of four quart (reputed) bottles. Three quart (reputed) bottles are to be supplied for Brandy and Varmouth. Exhibitors entering the same wine in more than one class must supply the full number of sample bettles for each entry.
  - 6. All wines will be judged on points.
- 7. No exhibitor will be awarded more than two prizes in any one class. Where an exhibitor has more than two entries in a class, only the exhibit securing the highest number of points shall be considered for the prises. The succeeding prises will be awarded in a similar manner among the remaining exhibitors in that class.
- S. The judge may award prizes on the basis of First, Second, Third, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended, but prize meney will only be allocated for first and second awards
- 8 Entries must be made on forme supplied by the Society for that purpose. Exhibitors must state on the entry form the class to be competed for, the distinguishing mark on the exhibits, character and vintage of the wine, and the quantity in stock-
- 10. No person will be allowed to inspect an entry form, after reception by the Secretary, until the Judges' awards bave been made public.
- 11. After the close of entries, no person will be permitted access to the exhibits, except the Judges, Secretary, and Staff, until the awards have been made
  - 18. Exhibits are to bear the labels supplied by the Society for that purpose, and must show:-
  - (a) The year of the Competition (1941)

  - Where more than one entry, the distinguishing mark of the entry to conform to the entry form.
  - (d) The year of vintage.
- (N.B -Bottles must not be labelled with business labels. Branded bottles and corks are permissible.)
  - 13. Brandy entries when drawn from Bond to be scaled by Custome officer.
- 14. Sparkling Wines not to be of older vintage than 10 years from date of exhibition, and to represent wines which can be purchased on the market
- 15. Exhibits to be delivered to the Secretary of the Society at the Sydney Showground in cases properly murked to show Exhibitor's name, not later than Baturday, 15th March, 1941
- 16. In all classes the wine in stoch as stated on the entry form may be inspected and checked by a representative of the Society or its nomines. Each exhibitor must supply the Society with a scaled envelope containing the record of any sale made subsequent to their entries being ledged, provided such sale has reduced the stipulated quantity below the minimum.
- 17. All exhibits to become the property of the Society. In disposing of the wine it shall be sold by public anction, and the proceeds of such to be donated to charity as associated by the Society.
- IS. Exhibite must represent stocks as set out on entry form, and be the bonn-fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.

19. All wine exhibits must be the sole produce of Australian grapes and free from any foreign substance. The Society reserves the right to have any exhibit inspected and/or analysed by one or more persons appointed for that

20. All exhibits must conform to the respective Wine or Food Acts of the States of New South Welce, Victoria, and South Australia.

21 No protest will be entertained if not made within three days after the close of the lest judging day of the Wine Section

22. No entry will be received from any person or persons disqualified by this or any other similar Society during the period of such disqualification. Should any such entry be accepted, it shall, when discovered, be deemed void and the entry fee and exhibit shall be forfeited to the Society.

23. Immediately after the closing date of entries a draw will be made for the selection of three exhibitors from whose entries a further draw will be made to enable one sample to be selected from each exhibitor. An efficiel of the flociety shell make an inspection of the quantity of such wine in accordance with the entry form, and his report will be later considered by the Committee.

24 All persons exhibiting shell accept the decision of the Judges appointed by the Society as to the morits of

25. No exhibitor will be permitted to occupy the position of Judge or Steward or become in any way identified with the judging or handling of the exhibits.

26. Any competitor making improper use of prisas won in the Wine Section for advertising purposes will be subject to disqualification.

#### INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES.

1. Judging of all wine exhibits to be on the following scale of points:-. . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . 10 pointa Flevour

2. The Judges shall have power to disqualify or dismiss, as being not eligible for judging, any exhibit which, in their opinion, does not comply with the regulations in every respect, and such disqualification or dismissal shall be accepted as final. The Judges shall have power to call in one or more persons, not being exhibitors, for consultative or edvisory purposes.

3. In the event of there being no competition in a close, Judges may award a prize or not, as they think fit. Prises may be withheld in any close where exhibits are considered unworthy.

4. Where, in the opinion of the Judge, a wine is not in accordance with the conditions, he shall, before make ing the award in the class, refer the metter to the Committee for enquiry.

5. The Judges have the discretionary power, in the event of an exhibitor wrongly classifying his exhibit, to place it in its proper class.

#### ENTRIES AND EXHIBITS.

All entries must be ledged with the Secretary. Endeavour House, 23 Macquarie Place, Sydney, on or be-fore Monday. 3rd March, 1941, and exhibits at the Wine Kiesk on Showground not later than Saturday, 18th March,

All sections open to growers and merchants,

The quantity in stock must (unless otherwise specified) be not less than the following, via :--Vintage, 1940, 300 gallons; Vintage, 1939, 200 gallons; Vintage, 1938, 100 gallons; Vintage, 1937, or older, 50 gallons.

An exhibition sample shall consist of four quart (reputed bottles), except for Brandy and Vermouth, for which three quart (reputed) bottles must be supplied.
