#### SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1. A cat may be entered in more than one class subject to the schedule as classified

2. All cata exhibited at the Show must be fed by the exhibitor.

3. Prize money will be paid according to the Judge's awards, and the number of cats exhibited.

All cats must be at the Lecture Hall at 8,30 a.m. on Monday, 7th April for examination by the Official Veterinary Surgeon of the Society. The examination will take place inside the hall; cats will not be examined outside the hall. If approved, the cat must be at once benched. Cats will not be benched or judged before having been so examined. No person, except the owner or his representative, will be allowed in the hall until after the cats have been examined and benched. Any cat showing symptoms of any disease must be removed from the Showground at once.

5. A challenge certificate may be awarded in each sex in Persians and Siamese classes if recommended by the Judge.

No cat shall be removed from the Show building between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., unless a veterinary certificate be produced stating that the cat is not fit to remain on the bench.

7. Delivery of Cata will commence at 6 p.m. on Monday, 7th April.

No eats shall be removed from the hall unless a " Pass-out " is obtained from the Superintendent.

 All cats must be judged in their cages, and prior to the judging there shall be no interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing
objects, such as coloured blankets, sanitary tims, etc. Plain white blankets will be allowed. The Judges will be instructed to pass any pen so distinguished.

10. No cat or kittens shall be removed from their cages during the Show for any purpose whatsoever without the authority of the

11. The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or mis-delivery of live-stock or other exhibits at the Society's Exhibition, or any damage thereto

12. The age of all cats will be the actual age on the day of competition.

13. All exhibits sold at the Exhibition, or prior to their return to the owner's residence, will be subject to a commission of 1 per cent if sold by auction, or 5 per cent if sold privately, on gross amount of sale.

Siamese cats can only be entered in Classes 71, 72, and 73.

#### PENALTY NON-EXHIBITION OF CATS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of cats which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show benches, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10/- for each and every entry of cat not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the cat or cats or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by the explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by the cat or acts becoming ineligible for the class in which they have been entered or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.
