Butter in all classes to be made from pasteurised cream and no preservative other than salt to be added.
 All butter exhibited may be subject to analysis.

BOXES.

All butter, specially manufactured and prepared for exhibition purposes, must be packed in PLAIN STANDARD LOCAL BOXES (BRANDED BOXES NOT PERMITTED).

Exhibitors failing to observe this Regulation are liable to disqualification.

For purposes of identification a label, bearing the full name of the exhibitor (Factory) together with full particulars of the class for which the exhibit is intended, must be securely affixed to the lid of each box before it is wrapped in its protecting cover.

The surface of the butter must be impressed with the Australian Roller brand.

An exhibitor who may desire to go through the exhibits with the judge, after judging day, shall make an appointment through the Steward-in-Chief or the Secretary.

Arrival and Departure of Exhibits.

Butter for classes as hereunder mentioned must be addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., Waterdale Cold Stores Pty., Ltd., 10 Point-st., Pyrmont, Sydney, and be delivered not later than the dates shown, viz. —

Class 2—Saturday, 4th January.	Class 6—During March.
Class 4—Wednesday, 12th February.	Class 7—Friday, 14th March.
Class 5—Wednesday, 12th February.	Class 8—Friday, 21st March.

For all other classes, butter to be addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., Showground, Moore Park, Sydney, and must be delivered at Showground not later than 5 p.m. on Monday, 31st March. All butter may be removed on Wednesday forenoon 9th April. Each factory must supply agent with delivery order to obtain butter.

Storage of Export Butter.

All exhibits for storage will be placed in cool chamber and kept at a temperature not exceeding 20 degrees. The exhibits will be removed from cold store to Showground in readiness for judging.

Unclaimed Exhibits.

All exhibits unclaimed on Wednesday, 9th April, will be sent to an agent and sold; the proceeds, less expenses, will be forwarded to exhibitor.

CONTINUOUS GRADING CLASS FOR BUTTER (LOCAL CONSUMPTION)—Special Prizes, £40, viz.: First prize, £20; second prize, £12 10s.; third prize, £5; fourth prize, £2 10s., and a Medal or Trophy to the butter-maker of the factory securing the first prize and a Silver Medal each to the makers of the second, third, and fourth prize exhibits. The factory to nominate the recipients of the medals.

A Gold Medal will be awarded each factory for an average of 93.5 per cent over the period of competition, provided that for any month the grading of the factory shall not be under the average of 93 points.

CONDITIONS.

Competition is for salted butter sold on the market in N.S.W.

Grading Period will extend from 1st March, 1947, to 28th February, 1948. From the consignments, one box may be taken for exhibition at the Show.

Factory competing must grade officially the choicest quality.

Official grading by the State Graders of all the choicest brands of factories entered for competition will be taken each month for the purpose of determining the results worked out by taking the average in which the number of boxes in each consignment, together with the grading points, is taken into account.

At least three gradings, including at least four representing at least two vats of cream in each consignment, must be recorded each month to enable a competitor to qualify for the prizes.

Grading points allotted by the State Graders for the full period and a box average calculated by dividing the total of the points allotted for the month by the total number of boxes in the exhibits obtaining the highest box average will be awarded the prizes.

The official grading by the Federal Officers of all the registered choicest brands of factories entered for this competition will be taken each month for the full period and results worked out by taking the actual mean average in which the number of boxes in each consignment, together with the grading points, is taken into account.

4. At least three gradings, including at least four churnings, representing at least two vats of cream in each grading, must be recorded each month to enable a competitor to qualify for the prizes.
