At the conclusion of the competitions a demonstration will be given by the Society's appointee.

Class 42 will be judged at 3 p.m., Tuesday, 1st April, and Class 43 at 3.30 p.m., the same day.

Prizes :- First and second, Royal Easter Show Medallion, third, Society's Certificate.
