## Sec. 16—Women's Handicrafts and Similar Work by Returned Servicemen—Needlework.

### REGULATIONS.

- Exhibitors will be allowed only one entry in any one class.
- The section is divided into two divisions, viz.:—  
 Amateur and Open.  
 Definition: An amateur, for the purpose of a Royal Easter Show, means an exhibitor who does not produce any specified article in this section for sale or receives any form of remuneration or fee or ex gratia payment in connection with any exhibit entered in any class in this section or at any similar show in the Commonwealth of Australia.  
 Open Classes. Amateur and professional exhibitors may both compete in this division.
- All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor. If any exhibit has been exhibited at any previous Show, particulars relating to such must be given on the certificate of entry. This Regulation will be strictly enforced.
- Exhibits that have been washed will be disqualified.
- No portion of a collection may compete as a single exhibit.
- Unless otherwise stated, no exhibit to consist of more than six specimens.
- Name or age of exhibitor will not be allowed on any exhibit.
- No factory made goods will be allowed.
- Each exhibit to consist of one article only, unless otherwise specified.
- An exhibit cannot be entered in more than one class.
- Non-competitive exhibits will not be received.
- Except where otherwise mentioned, articles may have seams and hems machine sewn, but all decorative work must be hand-work.
- "For Sale" cards or notices will not be permitted on exhibits.
- Exhibit numbers will be posted to exhibitors as early as possible after the closing date of entries. The exhibit number must be firmly fixed to every exhibit. A number must be affixed to each article making up a collection.
- All exhibits shall be inspected by a selection committee, appointed by the Society. The Committee shall have power to reject from exhibition any exhibit.

### ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS.

All exhibits (except selected Cookery Classes 73 to 99, 105 to 114) must be on the ground not later than 5 p.m., Wednesday, 12th March. No exhibits in such classes will be received after Wednesday, 12th March. Freight on exhibits sent by rail or carrier must be prepaid, and the exhibits should be addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., Showground, Moore Park, Sydney, and must also have on package name and address of exhibitors and class to be competed for. Exhibits sent by rail (prepaid) will be collected at Railway Station by the Society's carrier at the Society's expense.

Exhibits of selected Cookery (Classes 73 to 99, 105 to 114), to be delivered at Showground, not later than 9.30 a.m., on Monday, 31st March. No exhibits will be received after that hour.

**DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS** will commence at 11 a.m., on Wednesday, 9th April. Receipt for entry fees must be produced before delivery will be given. In order to facilitate the return of exhibits, competitors are requested to supply a full list of their exhibits and instructions as to their return. All exhibits (Cookery Classes excepted) unclaimed by Thursday, 10th April, will be despatched by Rail or Parcel Post.

Exhibits forwarded to the Show, as prescribed by the N.S.W. Railway regulations, will be returned by the Society in accordance therewith. Other unclaimed exhibits will be returned at the cost of the exhibitor concerned.
