MEASURING HORSES AND PONIES.

Horses, galloways, and ponics entered in classes for which the height is limited must be measured by the Official Measurer before competing. No exhibit shall be judged unless so measured. Should a horse, galloway, or pony be found by the Official Measurer to be over or under height for the class in which it has been entered it may be transferred to a corresponding horse, galloway, or pony class.

Horses, galloways, and penias will not be measured unless the breast plate showing their number in the class for which they are being measured in preduced to the Official Measurer, for the purpose of anabling him to impress same with a rubber stamp showing the official measurement and his initials.

The Official Measurer will issue a certificate as to height, and this certificate must be produced to the Steward at the entrance to the judging ring. Life certificate will not be issued.

The Official Measurer will attend at the Showground on Friday, Saturday, and Monday, 19th, 20th, and 22nd March, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Ponies will be measured on Friday and Saturday, 19th and 20th March.


