PENALTY-NON EXHIBITION OF PIGS

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10s, for each and every entry of pigs not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal or animals, or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by an explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered, or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

Prizes.—In addition to the cash prizes specified in each class, ribbons will be presented.

Age of pigs (litter classes excepted), to be calculated from the birth date shown in the litter registration in the herd book up to 1st April.

herd book up to lat April.

The age of pigs in litter classes shall be the actual age at the date of judging (Monday, 22nd March, 1948).

Full particulars must be stated on the certificate of entry of age, pedigree, herd book number if fixed. In the case where no number is fixed, proof or acceptance for herd book must be produced, except where otherwise specified. No pig shall be entered for a class for which it is not eligible on account of age. Exhibitors may be disqualified and debarred from further competition for any breach of this by-law.

No pig over 17 months of age shall be eligible to compete unless the date of farrow of the last progeny produced is shown on the cartificate of entry.

Boars over 15 months old must have had their tusks cut down within six weeks of judging day.

All pigs exhibited with a sow shall be her own progeny and not exceeding eight weeks old on day of judging

Any sow, entered in a sow and litter class, which has not farrowed at the time of judging, may compete in a dry class or vice versa. The exhibitor must advise the Secretary as early as possible to enable the transfer to be effected before the time of judging.

The removal from an exhibit of any natural markings or interference by staining, or otherwise, to dissemble natural markings will entail disqualification, and the exhibitor will be dealt with as the Council may deem fit.

Exhibitors will not be allowed more than three entries in any one class.

Exhibitors from other States should obtain from the Stock Branches of their own State and N.S.W. a "permit

to travel' before arranging to despatch the pigs to Sydney.

All pigs shall be fed and attended to by the exhibitor, who shall he responsible for the cleanliness and proper condition of the aties while the pigs remain on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, and shall be subject



SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

1. All classes are open for competition to wine growers and wine and spirit merchants.

2. A wine merchant shall mean any person, association, or company buying wine and brandy.

3. A wine grower shall mean any wine grower owning or occupying a vineyard, and manufacturing wine from grapes grown in such vineyard, or from grapes purchased for the purpose of wine-making.

4. Exhibitors may either be members or non-members of the Society. Entry fee: Members, 5s.; non-members, 10s.

5. Exhibitors will be allowed up to three entries in any one class. Each wine sample to consist of six quart (reputed) bottles. Four quart (reputed) bottles are to be supplied for Brandy and Vermouth. Exhibitors entering the same wine in more than one class must supply the full number of sample bottles for each entry.

6. All wines will be judged on points.

7. No exhibitor will be awarded more than one prize in any one class. Where an exhibitor has more than two entries in a class only the exhibit securing the highest number of points shall be considered for the prize. The succeeding prizes will be awarded in a similar manner among the remaining exhibitors in that class.

8. The judge may award prizes on the basis of First, Second, Third, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended, but prize money will only be allocated for first and second awards.

9. Entries must be made on forms supplied by the Society for that purpose. Exhibitors must state on the certificate of entry the class to be competed for, the distinguishing mark on the exhibits, character and vintage of the wine, and, when stipulated, the quantity

10. No person will be allowed to inspect a certificate of entry, after reception by the Secretary, until the Judges' awards have been

11. After the close of entries, no person will be permitted access to the exhibits, except the Judges, Stewards, Secretary, and Staff,

12. Exhibits are to hear the labels supplied by the Society for that purpose, and must show :-

(a) The year of the Competition (1948). (b) The number of the class.

(c) Where more than one entry, the distinguishing mark of the entry to conform to the certificate of entry.

(d) The year of vintage

(N.B.—Bottles must not be labelled with business labels. Branded bottles and corks are permissible.)

13. Sparkling Vines are to represent wines which can be purchased on the market.

14. Exhibits to be delivered to the Secretary of the Society at the Sydney Showground in cases properly marked to show Exhibitor's name, not later than Monday, 19th January, 1948.

15. In all classes the wine in stock as stated on the certificate of entry may be inspected and checked by a representative of the Society or its nomines. Each exhibitor must supply the Society with a sealed envelope containing the record of any sale made subsequent to their entries being lodged, provided such sale has reduced the stipulated quantity below the minimum.

16. Each exhibit of brandy must be accompanied by a declaration :—(a) that it conforms with the regulations. (b) that it has not been subjected to any treatment since its release from Bond. (c) that it has not been blended with any imported spirit or ilqueur.

17. All exhibits to become the property of the Society. In disposing of the wine it shall be sold by public auction, and the proceeds of such to be donated to charity as selected by the Society.

18. Exhibits must represent stocks as set out on the certificate of entry and be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time
