Chopping and Sawing will begin on **Tuesday, 23rd March**, and continue throughout the Show, commencing at 11 a.m., 2 p.m., and 7.30 p.m., on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Good Friday (Day only), Saturday, Monday, and Tuesday, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, 27th, 29th, and 30th March, 1948. Heat Winners, Unplaced Semi-Finalists, and Finalists.—In addition to the prize money in each class, 10s. will be awarded to each heat winner and unplaced competitor in semi-finals. £1 will also be awarded competitors who are unplaced in finals.

A Plumb Racing Axe will be donated by **MESSRS. FAYETTE R. PLUMB, INC., PHILADELPHIA, U.S.A.** (Agent, Harold J. Beer, 364 Lonsdale-st., Melbourne, C.1.) to the winner of each Wood-Chopping event. The donors will also present a Gold Medal to the winner of the "Silent Knight" World's Championship Wood-Chopping Contest, Event No. 5.

Forged Steel "Hytest" Racing Axes will be presented by **HYTEST AXE AND TOOL PTY., LTD., ALEXANDRIA, N.S.W., and Spotswood, Vic.**, to the winners of Events Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, 9 (2), 11, 12, and 13.

A Royal Easter Show Medallion will be awarded to each Champion in Events Nos. 5, 6, 7, and 11.

The "Britstand Trophy" for the most successful competitor. **THE BRITSTAND DISTRIBUTORS LTD. (N.S.W. Distributors for THE BRITISH STANDARD MACHINERY CO., LTD., Logging and Earth-moving Equipment Manufacturers, Mascot, Sydney)**, has presented the "Britstand Trophy" for the most successful competitor in single-handed wood-chopping events at each Royal Easter Show. The trophy shall be held in perpetuity by the Society, and the name of the winner each year shall be engraved thereon. The most successful competitor each year shall be presented with a miniature replica of the "Britstand Trophy," suitably engraved, and in addition a cash prize of £10. Should a competitor win the trophy three times in all, he shall receive a full size replica of same and a cash prize of £10.

The most successful exhibitor shall be decided on a point score basis, viz.:—Four points for champion and/or first prize; three points for second prize; two points for third prize; and one point for fourth prize.

The competitor gaining the greatest number of points shall be the winner. Should two or more competitors gain an equal number of points, a cash prize of £10 shall be equally divided among the competitors concerned, and the award of the replica will lapse for that year.

4. The contests will be chopped or sawn in heats as arranged by the Officials and a final according to the number of competitors. In the event of a competitor scratching from a heat after same has been posted or made public, he shall not be permitted to compete in another heat of the same event.

5. Competitors starting in an event must continue to chop or saw until the first and second logs are chopped or sawn off. Any competitor failing to comply with this rule will be disqualified from competing in any further event in the Show unless he can satisfy the Steward-in-Charge that he had broken his axe or saw or was exhausted.

6. The first and second competitors in each heat shall compete in the final.

7. No competitor will be allowed to make any axe or saw marks on his log, except foot holes for underhand events, before the gun fires which constitutes the word "go."

8. No person other than competitors, wedgers, or Officials, will be allowed in the ring during the contest.

9. At the completion of each contest the competitors must remain at their logs until placed by the Judge.

10. Axes or saws must entirely sever logs in two parts; pushing or pulling will disqualify

11. In Sawing Competitions all saw cuts must be three inches at least from the end of the log.

12. The decision of the Judge in all cases will be final as to places.

13. Competitors must be at their starting places 20 minutes previous to the advertised time of starting, otherwise the heat in which they are competing will be started without them.

14. A competitor will not start until his name has been called by the starter.

15. Competitors must wear white trousers, dark blue jerseys, white boots or shoes. This regulation will be rigidly enforced.

16. Any competitor conducting himself in an unruly manner, conspiring with others to cause discontent, to deceive the Officials, or infringing any of these conditions, may be disqualified or dealt with as the Council may deem fit.

17. The council may in its absolute and uncontrolled discretion disqualify, eliminate, or otherwise deal with any competitor in any wood-chopping or sawing contest on such grounds as it may think fit and without assigning any reason therefor.

18. Handicaps and Heats, as far as practicable, will be posted on a Notice Board in the dressing room one hour before the starting time of the event. A competitor who wins a contest after the declaration of handicaps may be rehandicapped for subsequent contests.

Handicapping limits, viz.:—(These times are at the discretion of the Officials.) Timber, 12-inch diameter, 25 seconds; 13-inch diameter, 30 seconds; 15-inch diameter, 35 seconds; 20-inch diameter, Double-Handed Sawing Contests, 12 seconds.
