CATTLE ATTENDANTS' COMPETITIONS. JUNIORS AND SENIORS.

These competitions are restricted to Juniors, who have not reached their 18th birthday at time of competition, and seniors, between the ages of 18 and 25 years, at time of competition, and are for the purpose of educating cattle attendants in the most efficient manner of parading stock before a judge. Cattle shall be selected by the Committee. Each competitor shall be allotted an animal which will be led into the judging ring and paraded before a judge as though the animal is being judged for type. The competitions shall commence as soon as the exhibits enter the judging ring. The prize shall be awarded to those competitors who, in the opinion of the judge, parade their animals in the most efficient manner. Account will be taken of difficulties which a competitor may have in controlling an exhibit.

At the conclusion of the competitions a demonstration will be given by the Society's appointee.

Class 22 will be judged at 3 p.m., Tuesday, 12th April, and Class 23 at 3.30 p.m., the same day.

Prizes:—First and second, Royal Easter Show Medallion, third, Society's Certificate.

Two Trophies, value £5 5s. each, are presented by John Fairfax and Sons Pty., Ltd., proprietors of the "Sydney Morning Herald," "The Home," and "Art in Australia," one each to the winner of Classes 22 and 23.
