SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

1. A cat may be entered in more than one class subject to the schedule as classified.
2. All cats exhibited at the Show must be fed by the exhibitor.
3. Prize money will be paid according to the Judge's awards, and the number of cats exhibited.
4. All cats must be at the Cat Pavilion at 8.30 a.m. on Saturday and Monday, 1st and 10th April, for examination by the Official Veterinary Surgeon of the Society. The examination will take place outside the Pavilion; cats will not be examined inside the hall. If approved, the cat must be at once benched. Cats will not be benched or judged before having been so examined. No person, except the owner or his representative, will be allowed in the hall until after the cats have been examined and benched. Any cat showing symptoms of any disease must be removed from the Showground at once.
5. A challenge certificate may be awarded in each sex and for each colour in Persians and for each sex in Royal Sacred Siamese classes if recommended by the Judge. The Judge may also award a Challenge certificate(s), in each sex, in the Any Other Colour classes (Classes 119 to 130) provided that the exhibit(s) is of a definite standard colour and for which there is no classification. The certificate(s) must be recommended for a standard colour and be, in the opinion of the judge, worthy of the award.
6. No cat shall be removed from the Show building between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., unless a veterinary certificate be produced stating that the cat is not fit to remain on the bench.
7. Delivery of Cats will commence at 8 p.m. on Saturday and Monday, 1st and 10th April.
8. No cats shall be removed from the hall unless a "Pass-out" is obtained from the Superintendent.
9. All cats must be judged in their cages, and prior to the judging there shall be no interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing objects, such as coloured blankets, sanitary tins, etc. Plain white blankets will be allowed. The Judges will be instructed to pass any pen so distinguished.
10. No cat or kittens shall be removed from their cages during the Show for any purpose whatsoever without the authority of the Superintendent.
11. First prize winners on Saturday, 1st April, are to be judged on Monday, 10th April, for Special Prizes.
12. The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or mis-delivery of live-stock or other exhibits at the Society's Exhibition, or any damage thereto.
13. The age of all cats will be the actual age on the day of judging.
14. Kittens shall not be eligible to compete in classes other than for kittens.
15. All exhibits sold at the Exhibition, or prior to their return to the owner's residence, will be subject to a commission of 1 per cent. if sold by auction, or 5 per cent. if sold privately, on gross amount of sale.
16. Should there be three or more exhibitors with three or more exhibits of the same colour entered in the Any Other Colour Class, a separate class or classes will be provided.
17. Cat or Cattery with contagious disease. An exhibitor who exhibits a cat which is known to have a contagious disease or has come from a cattery affected by a contagious disease during a period of three months immediately prior to the day of judging shall be cited for discreditable conduct and dealt with accordingly.

Royal Sacred Siamese Cats can only be entered in Classes 135 to 141.

PASSES.

Exhibitors of cats up to two exhibits, one pass; over two exhibits, two passes.
Judging to start at 9 a.m., Saturday and Monday, 1st and 10th April.

DEFINITIONS.

A "Kitten Class" is one confined to kittens under nine months of age up to and including the day of judging.
"Junior Classes" are confined to cats:—

- (a) Nine and under 12 months old, and
- (b) Nine and under 18 months old.

An "Open Class" is one confined to cats nine months old and over.
A "Neuter Class" is one confined to cats which have been sexed.
