





When measuring a horse, galloway or pony, an allowance of three-eighths (3 8) of an inch for shoes will be made. Should an Wibibit be measured with ithous on and the eibibitar disagree with the Official Measurer's decision as to the height of the animal, he may, should he so desire, have it re-measured without shoes. The Official Measurer may, in his discretion, request the removal of shoes from any horse, galloway, or pony, prior to measurement.

Should a horse, galloway, or ptony he found by the Official Measurer to he over or under height for the claim in which it has been entered it may he transferred to a corresponding horse, galloway, or pony clamb.

Herses, galloways, and ponias will not be measured unless tha breast plate showing their number in the class for which they are being measured is produced to the Official Measurer for the purpase of enabling him to imprass same with a rubber stamp showing tha official measurement and his initials.


