Butter in all classes to be made from pasteurised cream and no preservative other than salt to be added.
All butter exhibited may be subject to analysis.

BOXES.

All butter, specially manufactured and prepared for exhibition purposes, must be packed in PLAIN STANDARD LOCAL BOXES (BRANDED BOXES NOT PERMITTED).
All exhibits for Classes 2 to 9 to be addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., c/o. Waterside Cold Stores Pty. Ltd., 10 Point-st., Pyrmont, Sydney, and must be in cold store as stated in each Class.
Exhibitors failing to observe this Regulation are liable to disqualification.
For purposes of identification a label, bearing the full name of the exhibitor (Factory) together with full particulars of the class for which the exhibit is intended, must be securely affixed to the lid of each box before it is wrapped in its protecting cover.
The surface of the butter must be impressed with the Australian Roller brand.
An exhibitor who may desire to go through the exhibits with the judge, after judging day, shall make an appointment through the Steward-in-Chief or the Secretary.

Arrival and Departure of Exhibits.

Butter for classes as hereunder mentioned must be addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., Waterside Cold Stores Pty. Ltd., 10 Point-st., Pyrmont, Sydney, and be delivered not later than the dates shown, viz.:—
Class 3—Saturday, 7th January. Class 7—During March.
Classes 4 and 5—Wednesday, 25th January. Class 8—Friday, 24th February.
Class 6—Wednesday, 25th January. Class 9—Wednesday 22nd March.
For Class 10, butter to be addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., Showground, Moore Park, Sydney, and must be delivered at Showground not later than 5 p.m. on Thursday, 30th March. All butter may be removed on Thursday afternoon 13th April. Each factory must supply agent with delivery order to obtain butter.

Storage of Export Butter.

All exhibits for storage will be placed in cool chamber and kept at a temperature not exceeding 20 degrees. The exhibits will be removed from cold store to Showground in readiness for judging.

Unclaimed Exhibits.

All exhibits unclaimed on Thursday, 13th April, will be sent to an agent and sold; the proceeds, less expenses, will be forwarded to exhibitor.

CLASS 1—THE "BLUE STAR LINE" CONTINUOUS GRADING CLASS FOR BUTTER (EXPORT)
—Special Prizes, £40 and Open Orders, value £6 6s., are presented by the Blue Star Line (Aust.) Ltd., Scottish House, 17-19 Bridge Street, Sydney, viz.: First prize, £20; second prize, £12 10s.; third prize, £5; fourth prize, £2 10s.; and an Open Order, value £3 3s. each, to the manager and butter maker of the factory securing first prize.

A Medal or Trophy will be presented to the butter-maker of the factory securing the first prize and a Silver Medal each to the makers of the second, third, and fourth prize exhibits. The factory to nominate the recipient of the medals.

A Bronze Medal will be awarded each factory gaining a box average of 93.5 per cent over the period of competition, provided that for any month the average grading of the factory shall not be under choicest grade of 93 points.

CONDITIONS.

1. The competition is for salted or unsalted butter submitted and examined in N.S.W. for export to Great Britain.

Each consignment shall consist of not fewer than 50 boxes.

2. The Grading Period will extend from 1st November, 1949, to 28th February, 1950. From the consignments during the month of February, one box may be taken for exhibition at the Show.

3. The official grading by the Federal Officers of all the registered choicest brands of factories entered for this competition will be taken each month for the full period and results worked out by taking the actual mean average in which the number of boxes in each consignment, together with the grading points, is taken into account.

4. At least three gradings, including at least four churnings, representing at least two vats of cream in each grading, must be recorded each month to enable a competitor to qualify for the prizes.

5. The grading points allotted by the Federal Grader will be taken for the full period and a box average established by dividing the total of the points allotted to each consignment by the total number of boxes graded.

CLASS 2—CONTINUOUS GRADING CLASS FOR BUTTER (LOCAL CONSUMPTION)—Special Prizes, £40, viz.: First prize, £20; second prize, £12 10s.; third prize, £5; fourth prize, £2 10s., and a Medal or Trophy to the butter-maker of the factory securing the first prize and a Silver Medal each to the makers of the second, third, and fourth prize exhibits. The factory to nominate the recipient of the medals.

A Bronze Medal will be awarded each factory gaining a box average of 93.5 per cent over the period of competition, provided that for any month the average grading of the factory shall not be under choicest grade of 93 points.

CONDITIONS.

1. The competition is for salted butter sold on the local market in N.S.W.

2. The Grading Period will extend from 1st March, 1949, to 28th February, 1950. From the consignments, during the month of February, one box may be taken for exhibition at the Show.

3. Every factory competing must grade officially at least 85 per cent of its production as choicest quality.

4. The official grading by the State Officers of all the registered choicest brands of factories entered for this competition will be taken each month for the full period and results worked out by taking the actual mean average in which the number of boxes in each consignment, together with the grading points, is taken into account.

5. At least three gradings, including at least four churnings, representing at least two vats of cream in each grading, must be recorded each month to enable a competitor to qualify for the prizes.
