REGULATIONS.

1. Exhibitors will be allowed only one entry in any one class.
2. The section is divided into two divisions, viz. :—  
Amateur and Open.  
Definitions : An amateur, for the purpose of a Royal Easter Show, means an exhibitor who does not produce any specified article in this section for sale or receive any form of remuneration or fee or ex gratia payment in connection with any exhibit entered in any class in this section or at any similar show in the Commonwealth of Australia.  
Open Classes. Amateur and professional exhibitors may both compete in this division.
3. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR. IF ANY EXHIBIT HAS BEEN EXHIBITED AT ANY PREVIOUS ROYAL EASTER SHOW, IT SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT ANY SUBSEQUENT ROYAL EASTER SHOW. THIS REGULATION WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
4. Exhibits that have been washed will be disqualified.
5. No portion of a collection may compete as a single exhibit.
6. Unless otherwise stated, no exhibit to consist of more than six specimens.
7. Name or age of exhibitor will not be allowed on any exhibit.
8. No factory made goods will be allowed.
9. Each exhibit to consist of one article only, unless otherwise specified.
10. An exhibit cannot be entered in more than one class.

11. Non-competitive exhibits will not be received.
12. Except where otherwise mentioned, articles may have seams and hems machine sewn, but all decorative work must be hand-work.
13. "For Sale" cards or notices will not be permitted on exhibits.
14. Exhibit numbers will be posted to exhibitors as early as possible after the closing date of entries. The exhibit number must be firmly fixed to every exhibit. A number must be affixed to each article making up a collection.
15. All exhibits shall be inspected by a selection committee, appointed by the Society. The Committee shall have power to reject from exhibition any exhibit.
16. At the discretion of the Judges, exhibits gaining 50 or a lesser number of points shall not be displayed.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS.

Exhibits entered in the classes as hereunder shown must be delivered to the Showground not later than the time on the days stated. No exhibit will be received after the said hour:

Classes: 1 to 77; 102 to 108; 119 to 150—Wednesday, 15th March, 1950, at 5 p.m.

Classes: 91, 92, 94 to 97; 100 and 101—Saturday, 1st April, 1950, at 9 a.m.

Classes: 78 to 90; 93, 98, 99, 109 to 118—Wednesday, 5th April, 1950, at 9 a.m.

Freight on exhibits sent by rail or carrier must be prepaid, and the exhibits should be addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., Showground, Moore Park, Sydney, and must also have on package name and address of exhibitors and class to be competed for. Exhibits sent by rail (prepaid) will be collected at railway station by the Society's carrier at the Society's expense.

Delivery of exhibits in classes mentioned hereunder will commence on days and times as stated:—

Classes: 78 to 101 and 109 to 118—Monday, 10th April, 1950, at 8 p.m.

Classes: 1 to 77; 102 to 108; 119 to 150—Thursday, 13th April, 1950, at 11 a.m.

Receptacles in which exhibits are delivered to the Showground may be taken away by the exhibitor after delivery. Failing which, the Society will mark each receptacle for identification purposes and store same for ready delivery when the exhibit is collected by the exhibitor. This procedure will also apply to packing material for Wedding Cakes.

Receipt for entry fees must be produced before delivery will be given. In order to facilitate the return of exhibits, competitors are requested to supply a full list of their exhibits and instructions as to their return. All exhibits (Cookery classes excepted) unclaimed by Friday, 14th April, will be despatched by Rail or Parcel Post. Those exhibits not collected may be removed from exhibition.

Exhibits forwarded to the Show, as prescribed by the N.S.W. Railway regulations, will be returned by the Society in accordance therewith. Other unclaimed exhibits will be returned at the cost of the exhibitor concerned.

JUDGING POINTS.

Where applicable the exhibits shall be judged on points in accordance with the point score card attached to each exhibit. It shall be at the discretion of the Judges whether point cards are completed for exhibits gaining 50 or a lesser number of points.

NON-COMPETITIVE EXHIBITS AND DISPLAY STANDS RELUCTANTLY EXCLUDED.

Owing to the ever-increasing number of competitive exhibits and restricted accommodation the Society has been reluctantly compelled to restrict the exhibition to competitive exhibits.

NEEDLEWORK.

(Restricted to Amateurs.)

Exhibits entered in Amateur Classes 1 to 35 cannot be transferred to Open Classes 36 to 60. Should an exhibitor desire to compete in both sections, separate exhibits must be submitted for each class.
