1 Exhibitors of whisky, Kin, ruin, liqueurs and cider, must, with their certificate of entry, give an undertaking to abide by these

2. Exhibitors may either be members or non-membiors of the Society. Kntry Fee: Members, 7s. (ki.; non-n.embers, 12s. ekl. 3. Each exhibitor will be allowed up to three entries in any one class, except for liqueurs which shall be restricted to one entry of any one brand in each class. Kach exhibit shall consist of two reputed quarts or four reputed pints, drawn from Bond, and shall be of the alcoholic content prescribed for the class in which it is entered.

(N.B). -Bottles must not be labelled with business labels. Branded bottles and corks are permissible,)

4. No person shall enter any whisky, kin, rum, liqueur, and cider as an exhibit unless he has in stock, available for sale, a supply of such Spirit as stipulated in respect of each Hass of exhibit hereunder. A margin of variation of 2° in strength to lk* allowed for any exhibit, unless otherwise stated. Liqueurs must be made from natural extracts or flavourings, and must not contain synthetic flavourings. Exhibitors must state on the certificate of entry and the label the shift content of the Liqueur exhibited.

5. Exhibits must represent stocks as set out on certificate of entry and be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of

ft. No entry will be received from any person or persons disqualified by this or any other similar Society during the period of such disqualification. Should any such entry he accepted, it shall, when discovered, be deemed void and the entry fee and exhibit shall be forfeited to the Society.

7. No person, except as hereinafter stated, will be allowed to mspect a certificate of entry, after reception by the Spacetary, until the Judges' awards have been made public. To ensure that an exhibitor has entered in the corn of Section, a Sub-Committee comprising inemities of the Society's Wine Section Committee and The Wine ami Spirit Association of N.S.W. shall vet the applications after the

members of the Society's wine Section Committee and the wine and Spirit Association of three exhibitors from whose entries a limited date of entries a draw will be made for the selection of three exhibitors from whose entries a jurther draw will be made to enable one sample to like selected from each exhibitor. An official of the Society shall make an inspection of the quantity in accordance with the certificate of entry, and his report will be later considered by the Committee.

9. After the close of entries no #Hisson will list permitted access to the exhibits, except the Judges, Secretary, and Staff, until the awards have been made.

10. The acceptance of each entry shall be subject to: (a) that it conforms with these regulations: (b) that it has not been subjected to any treatment since its release from Bond: and (c) that it has not been blended with any imported spirit or liqueur.

Il Every exhibit must lie contained in a bottle clearly marked to show the nature of the exhibit, the year of exhibition, the number of the class in which it is entered, and the name of the exhibitor, and such bottles must be packed in cases or hampers or other suitable containers bearing the name and the address of the exhibitor which must is addressed to the Secretary, Royal Agricultural Society of New South Wales, Showground, Moore Park, Sydney, and but delivered to the Overseer's office on the Showground not later than Tuesday 31st January, 1950.

12. In all classes the stock as stated on the certificate of entry may lk*inspected and checked by a representative of the Society or its nominee. Each exhibitor must supply the Society with a sealed enveloper containing the record of any sale made subsequent to their entries being lodged, provided such sele has reduced the stipulated quantity M-bw the minimum.

13. No exhibitor will list awarded more than one prize in any one class. Where an exhibitor has more than two entries in a class, only the exhibits securing the highest number of points shall ist considered for the prize. The succeeding prizes will ist awarded in a similar manner among the remaining exhibitors in that class.

14. The judge may award prizes on the basis of First, Second, Third, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended, but prize money will only be allocated for first and second awards.

15. All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the Judges appointed by the Society as to the merits of their exhibits.

INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES.

1. The Judges shall have power ti disqualify or dismiss, as being not eligible for judging, any exhibit which, in their opinion, does not comply with the regulations in every respect, and such disqualification or dismissal shall he accepted as final. The Judges shall have power to call in one or more persons, not being exhibitors, for consultative or advisory purposes.

2. In the event of there being no competition in a class, Judges may award a prize or not, as they think fit. Prizes may be withheld in any class where exhibits are considered unworthy.

3. Where, in the opinion of the Judge, an exhibit is not in accordance with conditions, he shall, before making the award in the class, refer the matter to the Committee for enquiry.
