### PENALTY—NON EXHIBITION OF GOATS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show Yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of £1 for each entry of goats not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of Exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal or animals; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by the explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

### SPECIAL GOAT REGULATIONS.

Goats must be registered in a Herd Book recognised by the Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., and proof of registration must accompany all entries for the Show. All goats not of age for registration must be the progeny of registered sires and dams and definitely recorded in the kid register of the Goat Society of Australia. The age of all goats to be calculated from the birth date shown on the kid record and/or registration form up to the official judging day, Thursday, 22nd March.

All goats shall be fed and attended to by the exhibitor while the goat remains on the Showground. Goats will be judged at 9 a.m., Thursday, 22nd March, and will remain on exhibition on that day and until 5 p.m. on Easter Saturday, 24th March.

In awarding the Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete.

In awarding the Reserve Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative Sub-section, other than the exhibit to which the Championship has been awarded, shall be eligible to compete together with the second prize winner in the class in which the Champion was awarded first prize.

If a Champion shall be disqualified or shall be found to be unqualified to compete in the class for which it was entered, or to compete for the Championship then the Championship shall be awarded to the animal which was awarded the Reserve Championship.

### FODDER.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to arrange for his fodder requirements. The sale of all fodder is in the hands of the Official Produce Merchant, whose store on the Showground will be open during the Show.

Fodder shall not be admitted to or removed from the Showground without authority. For purposes of admission, a written order must be presented to the gatekeeper by the exhibitor or his representative, or by an outside merchant when making deliveries on behalf of an exhibitor. In the case of removal an official pass-out check is required. Admission orders and pass-out checks are obtainable from the Secretary.

For the convenience of exhibitors or other persons specially authorised to enter or leave the Showground with fodder, gates have been allocated as follows:—

- (1) Entry—Ferber Road.
- (a) From the Horse Station—Lang Road.
- (b) From the Cattle and Pig Sections—Paddington.

Conveyances may enter the Showground between 6 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. and must leave by 9.30 a.m. on ordinary days, or by 9 a.m. on Good Friday, Easter Saturday, and Easter Monday.

TYPE AND PRODUCTION CLASSES.

Conditions.

Exhibits entered in Classes 10 to 16 are restricted to does which have qualified for an Official Lactation Production Test Certificate at least thirty days before the first day of the Show, viz., 16th March. The age of each doe shall be calculated from the birth date shown on the kid record and/or registration form, but the points for production shall be based on the best official production record within three years prior to the 30th June of each year. Furthermore, the points shall be calculated on the basis of twice a day milking. The production shall be brought to a mature age standard.

Each exhibit shall be judged for type and production, viz.: 60 points for type and 40 points for milk and butter-fat production.

Each doe shall be credited with one point for every 100lb. milk over her age standard with a maximum of 20 points. Each doe shall also be credited with one point for every 5lb. butter-fat over her age standard with a limit of 20 points.
