

JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 9 A.M. AS FOLLOWS—

SATURDAY, 5th APRIL

PERSIANS : Kittens (all) Blue; Black; White; Cream; Neuters (all classes).

ROYAL SACRED SIAMESE : All classes.

MONDAY, 14th APRIL

PERSIANS : Kittens (mixed and marked); Chinchilla; Smoke; Shaded Silver; Silver Tabby; Red Tabby; Brown Tabby; Tortoiseshell; A.O.C.

NOTE.—For judging purposes at future Royal Easter Shows these groups will rotate.
All cats must be registered with the R.A.S. Cat Club, Endeavour House, 33 Macquarie Place, Sydney.

CAT PAVILION

The Cat Section will be situated in the Lecture Hall. Cats will be on exhibition on judging days only, until 6 p.m.

SPECIAL CAT REGULATIONS.

1. A cat may be entered in more than one class subject to the schedule as classified.
 2. All cats exhibited at the Show must be fed by the exhibitor.
 3. Prize money will be paid according to the Judge's awards, minus the number of cats exhibited.
 4. Cats must be at the Cat Pavilion at 8.30 a.m. on Saturday and Monday, 5th and 14th April, for examination by the Official Veterinary Surgeon of the Society. The examination will take place outside the Pavilion. Cats will not be examined inside the hall. If approved, the cat must be at once bunched. No person, except the owner or his representative, will be allowed in the hall until after the cats have been examined and bunched. Any cat showing symptoms of any disease must be removed from the Showground at once.
 5. If recommended by the Judge a challenge certificate may be awarded to each cat and for each colour in Persians, for each sex in Royal Sacred Siamese, and for Neuters. The judge may also award a challenge certificate to one or both sexes in the Any Other Colour Classes (Classes 131 to 144), provided the exhibitor gives definite standard colours for which no classification has been provided.
 6. No cat shall be removed from the show building between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., unless a veterinary certificate is produced stating that the cat is fit to remain on the beach.
 7. Delivery of cats will commence at 8 p.m. on Saturday and Monday, 5th and 14th April.
 8. No cat shall be removed from the hall unless a "Passout" is obtained from the Superintendent.
 9. Prior to the judging there shall be an interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing objects such as coloured blankets, sanitary time etc. The Judge will be instructed to pass over or pass on distinguishing. Plain white blankets with the addition of white cotton or lace linings in the edges, will be allowed.
 10. No cat or kitten shall be removed from its cage during the Show for any purpose whatsoever without the authority of the Superintendent.
 11. First prize winners on Saturday, 5th April, are to be judged on Monday, 14th April, for Special Prizes.
 12. The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or other exhibits of the Society's Exhibition, or any damage thereto.
 13. The age of all cats will be the actual age on the day of judging. A kitten is defined as being under nine months old at day of Judging.
 14. Kittens shall not be eligible to compete in classes other than for kittens.
 15. All sales of cats at the Exhibition, or prior to return to the owner's residence, will be subject to a commission of 1 per cent if sold by auction, or 1½ per cent if sold privately, on gross amount of sale.
 16. Should there be three or more exhibitors with three or more exhibits of the same colour entered in an Any Other Colour Class, a separate class of classes will be provided.
 17. Cat or Kitten with contagious disease. An exhibitor who exhibits a cat which is known to have a contagious disease or has come from a locality affected by a contagious disease during a period of three months immediately prior to the day of judging shall be fined for discreditable conduct and dealt with accordingly.
- Royal Sacred Siamese Cats can be entered only in Classes 131 to 144.
