JUDGING DAYS.

Judging will commence at:—
10 a.m., Thursday, 3rd April—Pork and Bacon Pigs—Classes 81 and 82—alive, and 7 a.m., Friday 4th April, carcasses.
9 a.m., Saturday, 5th April—Stud classes.

PAVILION OPEN TO PUBLIC.

The pavilion shall be open to the public daily from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. on the evenings of Saturday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, and Monday, 5th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 12th, and 14th April.

FODDER.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to arrange for his fodder requirements. The sale of all fodder is in the hands of the Official Produce Merchant, whose store on the Showground will be open during the Show.

Fodder shall not be admitted to or removed from the Showground without authority. For purposes of admission, a written order must be presented to the gatekeeper by the exhibitor or his representative, or by an outside merchant when making deliveries on behalf of an exhibitor. In the case of removal an official passout check is required. Admission orders and pass-out checks are obtainable from the Secretary.

For the convenience of exhibitors or other persons specially authorised to enter or leave the Showground with fodder, gates have been allocated as follows:—

- (i) Entry—Furber Road.
- (ii) Exit—(a) From the Horse Section—Lang Road.
(b) From the Cattle and Pig Section—Paddington.

Conveyances may enter the Showground between 6 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. and must leave by 9.30 a.m. on ordinary days, or by 9 a.m. on Good Friday, Easter Saturday, and Easter Monday.

SPECIAL PIG REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

All pigs (except those entered for bacon classes) over five months old must be registered with the Australian Pig Society, or a recognised Pig Stud Book Society. Pigs, including litters in sow and litter classes, must be from litters duly notified in accordance with the rules of the Australian Pig Society. For particulars apply to Branch Secretaries:—G. C. B. Marshall, 18 William-st., Perth; A. J. Stewart, 15 St. John-st., Launceston, Tas.

No animal other than an exhibit in respect of which application for entry has been accepted by the Society shall be brought on to the Showground by any exhibitor or other person except with the consent of the Secretary.

No animal other than an exhibit shall be displayed or exposed for sale on the Showground.

Every exhibitor warrants that he is the absolute owner of every animal brought by him or by his authority on to the Showground and agrees to indemnify and shall indemnify the Society against all claims on whatsoever ground and for whatsoever cause made against the Society in respect of such animal at the instance of any other person.

PENALTY—NON-EXHIBITION OF PIGS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10s. for each and every entry of pigs not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal or animals; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by an explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered, or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

Age of pigs (litter classes excepted), to be calculated from the birth date shown in the litter registration in the herd book up to 1st April.

The age of pigs in litter classes shall be the actual age at the date of judging (Saturday, 5th April, 1952).

Sec. 5—PIGS.

The name and breeding particulars of a boar or sow entered in a class for exhibits born after 1st November, 1951, may be furnished prior to the closing date of entries, or not later than the day before judging. Failure to observe this provision will automatically cancel the entry.

Full particulars must be stated on the certificate of entry of age, pedigree, herd book number if available. In the case where no number is available, proof of acceptance for herd book must be produced, except where otherwise specified.

No pig shall be entered for a class for which it is not eligible on account of age. Exhibitors may be disqualified and debarred from further competition for any breach of this by-law.

No pig over 7 months of age shall be eligible to compete unless the date of farrowing of the last progeny produced is shown on the certificate of entry.

Boars over 12 months old must have had their tusks cut down within six weeks of judging day. Upon arrival on the Showground all boars, over 12 months old, will be inspected by the Superintendent of the Section to ensure that this regulation has been observed. Exhibits not conforming with this regulation will be attended to by the Society's Veterinary Surgeon at the cost of the exhibitor.

All pigs exhibited with a sow shall be her own progeny and not exceeding eight weeks old on day of judging (Saturday, 5th April, 1952).

Any sow entered in a sow and litter class, which has not farrowed at the time of judging, may compete in a dry class or vice versa. The exhibitor must advise the Secretary as early as possible to enable the transfer to be effected before the time of judging.

All pigs exhibited in group classes must be paraded and judged as a group, and not on their awards in individual classes.

First and second prize sows in litter classes may compete individually for Championship and Reserve Championship prizes as defined hereunder.

In awarding the Championship, the Junior Champion and first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete.

In awarding the Reserve Championship, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section, other than the exhibit to which the Championship has been awarded, shall be eligible to compete, together with the second prize winner in the class in which the Champion was awarded first prize.

In awarding the Junior Championship, which prize is restricted to Berkshires, Large Whites, Middle Whites, and Tamworths, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Junior Championship if it is 12 months old or over.

The removal from an exhibit of any natural markings or interference by staining, or otherwise, to disassemble natural markings will entail disqualification, and the exhibitor will be dealt with as the Council may deem fit.

Exhibitors will not be allowed more than three entries in any one class.

Exhibitors from other States should obtain from the Stock Branches of their own State and N.S.W. a "permit to travel" before arranging to despatch the pigs to Sydney.

All pigs shall be fed and attended to by the exhibitor, who shall be responsible for the cleanliness and proper condition of the sties while the pigs remain on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, and shall be subject to the control of the Superintendent of the section appointed by the Society.

In the event of any pig being unfed, or any sty being in improper condition at any time while the pig remains on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, the officials of the Society shall feed and attend to the pig, and the cost of such feed and attendance shall be borne by the exhibitor of the pig.

Any exhibitor who may neglect to feed and properly attend to all pigs exhibited by him during the period through which they remain in the sties, either before or after the pig sales, shall be liable to disqualification after enquiry by the Council.

No pig shall be removed from its numbered pen without the sanction of the Superintendent.

Each exhibitor or his representative will be allowed to get in the pen and show his pig to the Judge, and must remain in the pen until the Judge has finished with that exhibit.

The Superintendent will take delivery on Showground of all exhibits, and at close of Show will deliver same and issue pass-out checks and return railway certificates.

Exhibits shall remain on exhibition until Tuesday, 15th April.

All exhibits must be penned before 9 a.m., judging to start at 9.30 a.m. on Saturday, 5th April, except for Classes 81 and 82 for which no.

SPECIAL NOTICE.

PIG STUDENTS.

Students from the Hawkesbury Agricultural College and the Veterinary School of the Sydney University will be appointed for the purpose of assisting exhibitors with the preparation of their pigs. Such assistance shall be available from the day before judging of the breed up to and including the day on which the breed is sold by Public Auction during the currency of the Show. Exhibitors desiring students must state on their Certificate of Entry the number they require. They shall also undertake to pay 10s. per day, for each student, towards the Society's expenses incurred by the appointment of the students. Should an exhibitor desire the services of students at an earlier or until a later date, the cost for the extra period shall be borne wholly by the exhibitor. Unless the aforesaid is observed the students shall not be available.

THE "A. F. GRAY MEMORIAL TROPHY"

(Special Prize)—The "A. F. Gray Memorial Trophy" (comprising a Shield and Memento), value £26 5s., and Royal Easter Show Medallion. Trophy presented by The Australian Pig Society (N.S.W. Branch), Endeavour House, 33 Macquarie Place, Sydney, for the Most Successful Exhibitor at Royal Easter Shows, to be allocated to the said exhibitor in the breed for the year stated, viz.:—1950, Berkshire; 1951, Large White; 1952, Middle White; 1953, Tamworth; 1954, Pork and Bacon classes and thereafter, again commencing with Berkshires, shall rotate in the order shown. The award shall be determined as follows:—For the five highest awards in each class points shall be allotted on the basis of 8, 5, 3, 2, and 1. Should there be fewer than five awards in any one class, the points shall be on the said basis in order of merit. In addition, there shall be three points for Champion, two for Reserve Champion, two for Junior Champion, and one for Reserve Junior Champion. Points shall not be awarded in classes where there are fewer than two exhibitors. In the event of two or more exhibitors securing an equal number of points, the exhibitor gaining the greatest number of first prizes shall receive the award. The "A. F. Gray Memorial Trophy" (Shield and Memento), before becoming the outright possession of one exhibitor, must be won on three occasions. The Shield shall be held by the winner until within one month of the succeeding Royal Easter Show, when it shall be returned to the Society. The Shield, Memento, and Medallion shall be suitably engraved with the name of each yearly winner.

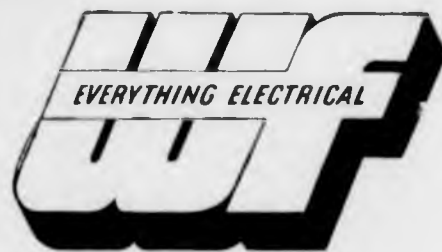

Pigs are to be weighed alive at 10 a.m. on Thursday, 3rd April, when a margin of 5lb. either under or over the specified weights will be allowed. At the conclusion of the live weighing, one pig from each pen will be sent to the State Abattoir, Homebush Bay, Sydney, where it will be killed and dressed. For the purpose of identification, each pig sent to the State Abattoir will be body-tattooed by the Society. The pig selected for slaughter shall be the lightest exhibit in the pen. This pig will be sectioned to ascertain the required measurements. The carcass will be cut into sides, one of which will be cut in half at the last rib. The carcass will then be judged in accordance with the abovementioned points. Cold weight will be taken simultaneously with the carcass appraisal. At the conclusion of the carcass judging the prize winning carcasses will be hung in the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board's refrigerated cabinet at the Royal Agricultural Society's Show, where they will remain until the termination of the Show. NO CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS.

In accordance with the recommendation made by the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia that a Championship Show shall be conducted in, and only in, the State in which the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia's Annual Conference is held, there shall be no Championship Awards in the Wine and Brandy Sub-Section of the 1952 Royal Easter Show.

SPECIAL WINES AND BRANDY REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

- All classes are open for competition to wine growers and wine and spirit merchants.
- A wine merchant shall mean any person, association, or company buying wine and brandy.
- A wine grower shall mean any wine grower owning or occupying a vineyard, and manufacturing wine from grapes grown in such vineyard, or from grapes purchased for the purpose of winemaking.
- Exhibitors may either be members or non-members of the Society. Entry fee:—Members, 7s. 6d.; Non-Members, 12s. 6d.
- Exhibitors will be allowed up to three entries in any one class. Each wine entry to consist of six quart (reputed) bottles in championship shows, and four quart (reputed) bottles in other shows. Four quart bottles are to be supplied for Brandy and Vermouth in each case. Exhibitors entering the same wine in more than one class must supply the full number of sample bottles for each entry.
- Wines may be judged on points.
- An exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in any one class.
- The judges may make awards on the basis of First, Second, Third, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended, but prize money will only be allocated for first and second awards.
- Entries must be made on forms supplied by the Society for that purpose. Exhibitors must state on the certificate of entry the class to be competed for, the distinguishing mark on the exhibits, character and vintage of the wine, and, when stipulated, the quantity in stock.
- No person will be allowed to inspect a certificate of entry, after reception by the Secretary, until the judges' awards have been made public.
- After the close of entries, no person will be permitted access to the exhibits, except the Judges, Stewards, Secretary and Staff, until the awards have been made.
- Exhibits are to bear the labels supplied by the Society for that purpose, and must show:—
 (a) The year of the Competition (1952).
 (b) The number of the class.
 (c) Where more than one entry, the distinguishing mark of the entry to conform to the certificate of entry.
 (d) The year of vintage.
 (N.B.—Bottles must not bear any labels other than those supplied by the Society. Branded bottles and corks are permissible.)
- Sparkling wines must represent wines with natural effervescence, the result of fermentation in bottle. Stock in hand at date of entry to be not less than 100 dozen reputed quarts or 200 dozen reputed pints.
- Exhibits to be delivered to the Overseer's Office at the Showground in cases properly marked to show exhibitor's name, not later than Thursday, 31st January, 1952.
- In all classes, the wine in stock as stated on the certificate of entry may be inspected and checked by a representative of the Society or its nominee. Each exhibitor must supply the Society with a sealed envelope containing the record of any sale made subsequent to their entries being lodged, provided such sale has reduced the stipulated quantity below the minimum.
- Immediately after the closing date of entries a draw will be made for the selection of three exhibitors from whose entries a further draw will be made to enable one sample to be selected from each exhibitor. An official of the Society shall make an inspection of the quantity of such wine in accordance with the certificate of entry and his report will be later considered by the Committee.
- Unless otherwise stated, all exhibits to become the property of the Society.
- Exhibits must represent stocks as set out on the certificate of entry and be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.
