PENALTY—NON-EXHIBITION OF GOATS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense and disarrangement of the Show Yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of £1 for each entry of goats not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Secretary of the Society before the day of Exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal or animals; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by the explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered, or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

JUDGING DAY AND EXHIBITION PERIOD.

Goats will be judged at 9 a.m., Thursday 2nd April, and will remain on exhibition on that day and until 5 p.m. on Easter Saturday, 4th April.

SPECIAL GOAT REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

Goats must be registered in a Herd Book recognised by the Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W. and proof of registration must accompany all entries for the Show. All goats not of age for registration must be the progeny of registered sires and dams and definitely recorded in the kid register of the Goat Breeders' Society of Australia. Marshall, Secretary, Western Australian Branch, William-st., Perth.

The age of all goats to be entered from the birth date shown on the kid record and on registration form up to the official judging day, 2nd April.

All Does will be milked dry, commencing at 4 p.m. Wednesday, 1st April, when an inspection will be made. The exhibitor or his representative to be present when the Does are being stripped out. Any Doe, which in the opinion of the steward, is carrying excessive milk shall be debarred from competition. Should the judge require any Doe to be milked out before making his award, same shall be done.

Any doe, entered as dry, if in milk at the time of the competition, may compete as a wet doe, and vice versa.

All goats shall be fed and attended to by the exhibitor while the goat remains on the Showground.

In awarding the Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative sub-section shall be eligible to compete.

In awarding the Reserve Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative sub-section, other than the exhibit to which the Championship has been awarded shall be eligible to compete together with the second prize winner in the class in which the Champion was awarded first prize.

In awarding the Junior Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative Sub-Section shall be eligible to compete, provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Junior Championship if it is over the age of two years and, in the case of a Saanen, if it is not a maiden.

In awarding the Reserve Junior Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative Sub-Section, other than the exhibit to which the Junior Championship has been awarded, shall be eligible to compete together with the second prize winner in the class from which the Junior Champion was drawn, provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Reserve Junior Championship if it is over the age of two years and, in the case of a Saanen, it is not a maiden.

If a Champion or Reserve Champion shall be disqualified or shall be found to be unqualified to compete in the class for which it was entered, or to compete for the Championship or Junior Championship, then the Championship or Junior Championship shall be awarded to the animal which was awarded the Reserve Championship or Reserve Junior Championship.

In all classes where only two or three prizes are offered, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended cards may be recommended at the discretion of the judge.

DATES OF BIRTH FOR CLASSES RESTRICTED BY AGE

Stated hereunder is an explanation regarding classes which restrict the eligibility of an exhibit by the fact of its age. The dates shown within the parenthesis are those on, or between which, the exhibit must be born to enable it to compete in the class referred to immediately preceding the parenthesis.

Age—Over 5 years (before 2nd April, 1948); over 4 years (before 2nd April, 1949); over 3 and not over 5 years (2nd April, 1948—1st April, 1949); not over 4 years (on or after 2nd April, 1949); over 3 and not over 4 years (2nd April, 1949—1st April, 1950); not over 3 years (on or after 2nd April, 1950); over 2 and not over 3 years (2nd April, 1950—1st April, 1951); over 2 years (on or before 1st April, 1951); not over 2 years (on or after 2nd April, 1951); over 12 months and not over 2 years (2nd April, 1951—1st April, 1952); not over 12 months (on or after 2nd April, 1952); over 6 and not over 12 months (2nd April—1st October, 1952) over 3 and not over 6 months (2nd October, 1952—1st January, 1953).
