MONDAY, 19th APRIL ROYAL SACRED SIAMESE: All classes.

NOTE.—For judging purposes at future Royal Easter Shows these groups will rotate.

All cats must be registered with the R.A.S. Cat Club, Endeavour House, 33 Macquarie Place, Sydney.

CAT PAVILION

The Cat Section will be situated in the Lecture Hall. Cats will be on exhibition on judging days only, until 5 p.m.

TROPHIES ON DISPLAY

Trophies offered for competition in the Cat Section shall be on display in the special windows provided for the purpose in the Society's General Showground Office.

SPECIAL CAT REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

1. A cat may be entered in more than one class subject to the schedule as classified.
2. All cats exhibited at the Show must be fed by the exhibitor.
3. Prize money will be paid according to the Judge's awards, and the number of cats exhibited.
4. Cats must be at the Cat Pavilion at 8.30 a.m. on Saturday and Monday, 10th and 19th April, for examination by the Official Veterinary Surgeon of the Society. The examination will take place outside the Pavilion. Cats will not be examined inside the hall. If approved, the cat must be at once benched. No person, except the owner or his representative, will be allowed in the hall until after the cats have been examined and benched. Any cat which shows symptoms of any disease, is lice infested and/or dirty must be removed from the Showground at once.
5. If recommended by the Judge a challenge certificate may be awarded to each sex and for each colour in Persians, for each sex in Royal Sacred Siamese, and for Neuters. The judge may also award a challenge certificate to one or both sexes in the Any Other Colour Classes (Classes 85 to 92, provided the exhibits are of definite standard colours for which no classification has been provided).
6. No cat shall be removed from the Show building between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m., unless a veterinary certificate be produced stating that the cat is not fit to remain on the bench.
7. Delivery of cats will commence at 5 p.m. on Saturday and Monday, 10th and 19th April.
8. No cats shall be removed from the hall unless a "Pass-out" is obtained from the Superintendent.
9. Prior to the judging there shall be no interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing objects, such as coloured blankets, sanitary tins, etc. The Judges will be instructed to pass any pen so distinguished. Plain white blankets with the addition of white cotton or linen linings in the cages, will be allowed.
10. No cat or kittens shall be removed from their cages during the Show for any purpose whatsoever without the authority of the Superintendent.
11. Where a Special Prize is offered for competition among exhibits judged on Saturday, 10th April, and Monday, 19th April, the First Prize winners eligible for such Special Prize will be judged on Monday, 19th April.
12. The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or other exhibits at the Society's Exhibition, or any damage thereto.
13. The age of all cats will be the actual age on the day of judging. A kitten is defined as being six months old and under nine months old at day of judging.
14. The entry for a kitten under six months old shall not be accepted.
15. Kittens shall not be eligible to compete in classes other than for kittens.

16. All sales of cats at the Exhibition, or prior to return to the owner's residence, will be subject to a commission of 1 per cent. on gross amount of sale.
17. Should there be three or more exhibitors with three or more exhibits of the same colour entered in an Any Other Colour Class, a separate class or classes will be provided.
18. Cat or Cattery with contagious disease. An exhibitor who exhibits a cat which is known to have a contagious disease or has come from a cattery affected by a contagious disease during a period of three months immediately prior to the day of judging shall be cited for discreditable conduct and dealt with accordingly. Royal Sacred Siamese Cats can be entered only in Classes 101 to 111.

PASSES

Exhibitors of cats, up to two exhibits, one pass; over two exhibits, two passes.

DEFINITIONS

A "Kitten Class" is one confined to kittens, six months old and not over nine months of age up to and including the day of judging.

"Junior Classes" are confined to cats:—

- (a) Nine months old and not over 12 months, and
(b) Nine months old and not over 18 months.

An "Open Class" is one confined to cats nine months old and over.

A "Neuter Class" is one confined to cats which have been desexed.

SPECIAL PRIZES

The minimum value of all Cups and Trophies shall be £3 3s.
