SPECIAL ARTS AND CRAFTS REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

1. Exhibitors will be allowed only one entry in any one class.
2. EACH EXHIBIT MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR. AN ARTICLE WHICH HAS BEEN EXHIBITED AT A PREVIOUS ROYAL EASTER SHOW SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE. THESE CONDITIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
3. Exhibits (with the exception of weaving) that have been washed will be disqualified.
4. No portion of a collection may compete as a single exhibit.
5. Name or age of exhibitor will not be allowed on any exhibit.
6. No factory made goods will be allowed.
7. Each exhibit to consist of one article only, unless otherwise specified.
8. An exhibit cannot be entered in more than one class.
9. Non-competitive exhibits will not be received.
10. Except where otherwise mentioned, articles may have seams and hems machine sewn, but all decorative work must be hand-work.
11. "For Sale" cards or notices will not be permitted on exhibits.
12. Exhibit numbers will be posted to exhibitors as early as possible after the closing date of entries. The exhibit number must be firmly fixed to every exhibit. A number must be affixed to each article making up a collection.
13. All exhibits shall be inspected by a selection committee, appointed by the Society. The Committee shall have power to reject from exhibition any exhibit.
14. At the discretion of the Judges exhibits considered not up to an approved standard shall not be displayed.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS.

Exhibits entered in the classes as hereunder shown may be delivered to the Showground at any time but not later than the time on the days stated. No exhibit will be received after the said hour.

Classes:—185 to 205, 208 to 210, 213 to 215, 229 to 234—Tuesday, 16th April, at 12 noon.

TO FACILITATE THE HANDLING OF ENTRIES, EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO FORWARD OR DELIVER THEIR EXHIBITS TO THE SHOWGROUND, PRIOR TO THE DATE SET DOWN FOR THE FINAL RECEIPT OF EXHIBITS.

Freight on exhibits sent by rail or carrier must be pre-paid, and the exhibits should be addressed to the Director, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., Showground, Moore Park, Sydney, and must also have on package name and address of exhibitor and class to be competed for. Exhibits sent by rail (pre-paid) will be collected at railway station by the Society's carrier at the Society's expense.

Return of all exhibits will commence on Thursday, 25th April, at 11 a.m.

Receptacles in which exhibits are delivered to the Showground may be taken away by the exhibitor after delivery, failing which, the Society will mark each receptacle for identification purposes and store same for ready delivery when the exhibit is collected by the exhibitor. This procedure will also apply to packing material for Wedding Cakes.

Receipt for entry fee must be produced before delivery will be given. In order to facilitate the return of exhibits, competitors are requested to supply a full list of their exhibits and instructions as to their return. All exhibits (Cookery classes excepted) unclaimed by Friday, 3rd May, will be despatched by Rail or Parcel Post. Those exhibits not collected may be removed from exhibition.

Exhibits forwarded to the Show, as prescribed by the N.S.W. Railway regulations, will be returned by the Society in accordance therewith. Other unclaimed exhibits will be returned at the cost of the exhibitor concerned.
