

#### MEASURING HORSES AND PONIES.

Horses, galloways, and ponies entered in classes for which the height is limited must be measured by the Official Measurer before competing. No exhibit shall be judged unless so measured.

THE OFFICIAL MEASURER WILL ATTEND THE SHOW-GROUND ON WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY, FRIDAY, AND SATURDAY, 10th, 12th, and 13th APRIL. AN EXHIBIT WILL NOT BE MEASURED ON THE DAY IT IS TO BE

When measuring a horse, galloway, or pony, on allowance of half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  of an inch is to be made for shoes. Where on exhibitor disagrees with the Official Measurer's figure for on animal which has been measured with shaes on he may, should he so desire, have t re-measured without shoes. The Official Measurer may, in his discretion, request the removal of shoes from any animal prior to measurement.

Should a horse, galloway, or pony be found by the Official Measurer to be over or under height for the class in which it has been entered it may be transferred to a corresponding horse, galloway, or pony class.

Horses, galloways, and panies will not be measured unless the breast plate showing their number in the class for which they are being measured is produced to the Official Measurer for the purpose of enabling him to impress some with a rubber stamp showing the official measurement and

Life measurement certificates will only be issued for horses, gallaways, or ponies, seven years old or over. A Life Certificate shall not be issued unless, at the time of measurement, the exhibit is unshad.

The Official Measurer will attend the Shawground on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, 10th, 11th, 12th, and 13th April, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. A pany will not be measured on the day it is to be judged. Should a pony be found by the Official Measurer to be over ar under height for the class in which it has been entered it may be transferred to a corresponding pany or horse saddle


