## PENALTY—NON-EXHIBITION OF GOATS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show Yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of £1 for each entry of goats not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Director of the Society before the day of Exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal or animals; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by the explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered, or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

## JUDGING DAY AND EXHIBITION PERIOD.

Goats will be judged at 9 a.m., Thursday, 18th April, and will remain on exhibition on that day and until 5 p.m. on Easter Saturday, 20th April.

## SPECIAL GOAT REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

Goats must be registered in a Herd Book recognised by the Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., and proof of registration must accompany all entries for the Show. For particulars of the Goat Breeders' Society of Australia, apply to the Secretary, F. H. Berryman, Endeavour House, 33 Macquarie Place, Sydney; H. T. C. Woodfull, Secretary, Victorian Branch, Temple Court, 422 Collins-st., Melbourne; H. J. Finnis, Secretary, South Australian Branch, 7 Pirie-st., Adelaide; J. B. Marshall, Secretary, Western Australian Branch, 239-248 Adelaide Terrace, Perth.

The age of all goats to be calculated from the birth date shown on the kid record and/or registration form up to the official Judging day, Thursday, 18th April.

All Does will be milked dry, commencing at 5 p.m., Wednesday, 17th April, when an inspection will be made. The exhibitor or his representative to be present when the Does are being stripped out. Any Doe which in the opinion of the steward is carrying excessive milk shall be debarred from competition. Should the judge require any Doe to be milked out before making his award, same shall be done.

Any doe, entered as dry, if in milk at the time of the competition, may compete as a wet doe, and vice versa.

All goats shall be fed and attended to by the exhibitor while the goat remains on the Showground.

In awarding the Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative sub-section shall be eligible to compete.

In awarding the Reserve Championship, the first prize winner in each class of the relative sub-section, other than the exhibit to which the Championship has been awarded, shall be eligible to compete together with the second prize winner in the class in which the Champion was awarded first prize.

In awarding the Junior Championship, the first prize winner in each class in the relative sub-section shall be eligible to compete, provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Junior Championship if it is over the age of two years and, in the case of a Saanen, if it is not a maiden.

In awarding the Reserve Junior Championship, the first prize winner in each class in the relative sub-section, other than the exhibit to which the Junior Championship has been awarded shall be eligible to compete together with the second prize winner in the class from which the Junior Champion was drawn, provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Reserve Junior Championship if it is over the age of two years and, in the case of a Saanen, if it is not a maiden.

If a Champion or Reserve Champion shall be disqualified or shall be found to be unqualified to compete in the class for which it was entered, or to compete for the Championship or Junior Championship then the Championship or Junior Championship shall be awarded to the animal which was awarded the Reserve Championship or Reserve Junior Championship.

In all classes where only two or three prizes are offered, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended cards may be recommended at the discretion of the judge.

## DATES OF BIRTH FOR CLASSES RESTRICTED BY AGE.

Stated hereunder is an explanation regarding classes which restrict the eligibility of an exhibit by the fact of its age. The dates shown within the parentheses are those on, or between which, the exhibit must be born to enable it to compete in the class referred to immediately preceding the parentheses.

Age—Over 5 years (before 18th April, 1952); over 4 years (before 18th April, 1953); over 4 years and not over 5 years (18th April, 1952-17th April, 1953); not over 4 years (on or after 18th April, 1953); over 3 years and not over 4 years (18th April, 1953-17th April, 1954); not over 3 years (on or after 18th April, 1954); over 2 years and not over 3 years (18th April, 1954-17th April, 1955); over 2 years (before 18th April, 1955); not over 2 years (on or after 18th April, 1955); over 17 months and not over 2 years (18th April-17th November, 1955); over 12 months and not over 2 years (18th April, 1955-17th April, 1956); over 12 months and not over 17 months (18th November, 1955-17th April, 1956); not over 12 months (on or after 18th April, 1956); over 7 months and not over 12 months (18th April-17th September, 1956); over 5 months and not over 7 months (18th September-17th November, 1956); not over 5 months (on or after 18th November, 1956).

TYPE AND PRODUCTION CLASSES.

Conditions.

Exhibits entered in Classes 1 to 7 are restricted to Does which have qualified for a State Official Production Certificate not later than 31st December, prior to the next Royal Easter Show. The age of each Doe shall be calculated from the birth date shown on the kid record and/or registration form, but the points for production shall be based on the best official production record within the period 1st January, 1954, to 31st December, 1956. Furthermore, the points shall be calculated on the basis of twice-a-day milking. Yields of Does milked three times a day will be reduced in proportion to twice-daily milkings. The production shall be brought to a mature age standard.

Each exhibit shall be judged for type and production, viz.:—60 points for type and 40 points for milk and butter-fat production.

Each Doe shall be credited on the basis of one point for every 100lb. of milk or part thereof over her age standard with a maximum of 20 points. Each Doe shall also be credited with one point for every 5lb. of butter-fat or part thereof over the mature age standard with a maximum of 20 points.

In addition, there shall be 3 points for Champion, 2 for Reserve Champion, 2 for Junior Champion, and 1 for Reserve Junior Champion. In the event of two or more Bucks securing an equal number of points the owner of the Buck gaining the greatest number of first prizes shall be the winner.

**GOAT PARADERS' COMPETITION. CONDITIONS.**

This competition is for the purpose of educating and encouraging goat exhibitors and attendants to parade exhibits before a judge in the most efficient manner. Suitable attire of competitors and condition of animals, although highly desirable, shall not be the deciding factor except in the case of equality of competitors.

The Paraders' Competition shall be restricted to exhibitors and their herdsmen.

The competition shall commence as soon as the exhibits in each class enter the Judging Ring on Thursday, 18th April. The selected competitors shall be those who, in the opinion of the competition selectors, parade their animals in the most efficient manner. Account will be taken of difficulties which a competitor may have in controlling an exhibit.

A competitor shall not be placed at an advantage or disadvantage as a result of parading animals in a less or greater number of classes.

Each competitor shall be allotted an armband number which must be worn in each class. The armband number shall be the only form of identification.
