PAVILION OPEN TO PUBLIC.

The Pavilion shall be open to the public daily from 9.80 a.m. to 5 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. on the evenings of Friday, Saturday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, and Monday, 12th, 13th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 20th and 22nd April.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to arrange for his fodder requirements. The sale of II fodder is in the hands of the Official Produce Merchant, whose store on the Showground will be open during the Show.

Fodder shall not be admitted to or removed from the Showground without authority. SPECIAL PIG REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations,

All pigs (except those entered for bacon classes) over five months old must be registered with the Australian Pig Society, or a recognised Pig Stud Book Society. Pigs. including litters in sow and litter classes, must be from litters duly notified in accordance with the rules of the Australian Pig Society. For particulars apply to Branch Secretaries:—Lt.-Gen. Sir Frank H. Berryman. Endeavour House, 33 Macquarie Place, Sydney; H. T. C. Woodfull, Temple Court, Collinsat., Melbourne; F. J. Kennedy, Primary Building, Creek-st., Brisbane; H. J. Finnis, 7 Pirie-st., Adelaide; J. B. Marshall, 239-243 Adelaide Terrance, Perth; J. S. Millen, 1-21 St. John-st., Launceston, Tas.

No animal other than an exhibit in respect of which application for entry has been accepted by the Society shall be brought on to the Showground by any exhibitor or other person except with the consent of the Director.

No animal other than an exhibit shall be displayed or expressed for sale on the Showground.

No animal other than an exhibit shall be displayed or exposed for sale on the Showground.

Every exhibitor warrants that he is the absolute owner of every animal brought by him or by his authority on to the Showground and agrees to indemnify and shall indemnify the Society against all claims on whatsoever ground and for whatsoever cause made against the Society in respect of such animal at the instance of any other person.

PENALTY-NON-EXHIBITION OF PIGS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10s, for each and every entry of pigs not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Director of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal or animals; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by an explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered, or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

Age of pigs (litter classes excepted) to be calculated from the birth date shown in the litter registration in the herd book up to 1st April.

The age of pigs in litter classes shall be actual age at the date of judging (Friday, 12th April, 1217).

The name and breeding particulars of a boar or sow entered in a class for exhibits born after has November, 1936, may be furnished prior to the closing date of entries, or not later than the day before judging. Failure to observe this

provision will automatically cancel the entry. From will automatically cancel the entry.

Full particulars must be stated on the certificate of entry of age, pedigree, herd book number if available. In the case where no number is available, proof of acceptance for herd book must be produced, except where otherwise specified.

No pig shall be entered for a class for which it is not eligible on account of age. Exhibitors may be disqualified and debarred from further competition for any breach of this by-law.

No pig over 17 months of age shall be eligible to compete unless the date of farrowing of the last progeny produced is

shown on the certificate of entry.

Boars over 12 months old must have had their tunks cut down within six weeks of judging day. Upon arrival on the Showground all boars, over 12 months old, will be inspected by the Superintendent of the Section to ensure that this regulation has been observed. Exhibits not conforming with this regulation will be attended to by the Society's Veterinary Surgeon at the cost of the exhibitor.

All pigs exhibited with a sow shall be her own progeny and not exceeding eight weeks old on day of judging (Friday

Any sow entered in a sow and litter class, which has not farrowed at the time of judging, may compete in a dry or vice versa. Such transferred entry shall be additional to any entries made by the exhibitor in the relative class The exhibitor must advise the Director as early as possible to enable the transfer to be effected before the time of

All pigs exhibited in group classes must be paraded and judged as a group, and not on their awards in individual

First and second prize sows in litter classes may compete individually for Championship and Reserve Championship prizes as defined hereunder.

In awarding the Championship, the Junior Champion, and first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete.

relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete.

In awarding the Reserve Championship, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section, other than the exhibit to which the Championship has been awarded, shall be eligible to compete, together with

the second prize winner in the class in which the Champion was awarded first prize. In awarding the Junior Championship, which prize is restricted to Berkshires, Large Whites, Tamworths, and Wessex Saddlebacks, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete

Saddlebacks, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Junior Championship if it is over 12 months old.

Each Selling Agent who makes a sale or sales of pigs situated on the Showground or of pigs after leaving the Showground but before the pigs have reached the destination to which they were sent from the Showground shall pay to the Society a rental equivalent to one per cent of the gross proceeds of the sale or sales.

The removal from an exhibit of any natural markings will entail disqualification, and the exhibitor will be dealt with as the Council may deem fit.

Exhibitors from other States should obtain from the Stock Branches of their own State and N.S.W. a "Fermit to travel" before arranging to desirable the nime to Schow.

In the event of any pig being unfed, or any sty being in improper condition at any time while the pig remains on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, the officials of the Society shall feed and attend to the pig, and the cost of such feed and attendance shall be borne by the exhibitor of the pig.

Any exhibitor who may neglect to feed and properly attend to all pigs exhibited by him during the period through which they remain in the sties, either before or after the pig sales, shall be liable to disqualification after enquiry by the

No pig shall be removed from its numbered pen without the sanction of the Superintendent.

Each exhibitor or his representative will be allowed to get in the pen and show his pig to the Judge, and must remain in the pen until the Judge has finished with that exhibit.

The Superintendent will take delivery on Showground of all exhibits, and at close of Show will deliver same and issue

The Superintendent will take delivery on Snowground of all exhibits, and at close of Show will delive and the same pass-out checks and return railway certificates.

INSPECTOR'S VERIFICATION OF TYPE, DESCRIPTION AND ELIGIBILITY.

- (c) No inapector shall be required to furnish to the exhibitor any reasons for his determination nor shall there be any appeal against such determination at the instance of the exhibitor provided always that the Steward-in-Chief or Assistant Steward-in-Chief of the Pig Section of the particular class in which such animal is entered for exhibition may override any such determination and permit the animal to remain on the Showground with or without the right of being paraded and or exhibited as such Steward-in-Chief or Assistant Steward-in-Chief may, in his absolute discretion determine.
- (d) The Australian Pig Society (N.S.W. Branch) shall be requested to nominate three persons qualified to act as inspectors in order to facilitate the appointment of an inspector or inspectors by the Society for the purpose of this regulation.

DATES OF BIRTH FOR CLASSES RESTRICTED BY AGE.

Stated hereunder is an explanation regarding classes which restrict the eligibility of an exhibit by the fact of its age. The dates shown within the parentheses are those on, or between which, the exhibit must be born to enable it to compete in the class referred to immediately preceding the parentheses.

Age—over 17 months and not over 4 years (1st April, 1953; 31st Oct., 1955); over 12 and not over 17 months (1st Nov., 1955; 31st March, 1956); bear not over 12 months and 3 sows over 7 months (bear, on or after 1st April, 1956; sows, before 1st Sept., 1956); over 8 and not over 12 months (1st April, 31st July, 1956); over 5 and not over 8 months (1st Aug., 31st Oct., 1956); not over 7 months (on or after 1st Nov., 1956); not over 4 months (on or after 1st Nov., 1956); litter not over 8 weeks (on or after 15th February, 1957).

PIG STUDENTS.

Students from the Hawkesbury Agricultural College and the Veterinary School of the Sydney University will be appointed for the purpose of assisting exhibitors with the preparation of their pigs. CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS.

In accordance with the recommendation made by the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia that a Championship In accordance with the recommendation made by the roughly viticultural Council of Australia that a Championship Show shall be conducted in, and only in, the State in which the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia's Annual Conference is held, there shall be Championship Awards in the Wine and Brandy Sub-Section of the 1957 Royal Easter Show.

Judges' awards will not be released until Thursday, 4th April.

SPECIAL WINES AND BRANDY REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

1. All classes are open for competition to wine growers and wine and spirit merchants.

2. A wine merchant shall mean any person, association, or company buying wine and brandy.

3. A wine grower shall mean any wine grower owning or occupying a vineyard, and manufacturing wine from grapes grown in such vineyard, or from grapes purchased for the purpose of winemaking.

4. Exhibitors may either be Members, Associate-Members, or Non-Members of the Society. Entry Fee-Members and Associate-Members, 7s. 6d.; Non-Members, 12s. 6d.

5. Exhibitors will be allowed up to three entries in any one class with the exception of Class 30 (Collection of Wines) for which only one entry will be allowed. Each entry to consist of six quart (reputed) bottles. Exhibitors entering the same wine in more than one class must supply the full number of sample bottles for each entry.

6. Wines may be judged on points.
7. An exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in any one class.
