JUDGING DAY

Unless otherwise stated the judging of Dairy Produce exhibits will commence at 9 a.m., Thursday, 31st March.

PAVILION OPEN TO PUBLIC.

The Dairy Produce Pavilion will be open to the public daily from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m., except Good Friday, 8th April, on which day the Pavilion will close at 6 p.m.

TROPHIES ON DISPLAY.

Trophies offered for competition in the Dairy Produce Section shall be on display in the special windows provided for the purpose in the Society's General Showground Office.

SPECIAL DAIRY PRODUCE REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

BUTTER.

Butter in all classes to be made from pasteurised cream and no preservative other than salt to be added.

All butter exhibited may be subject to analysis.

Butter, other than that in cold storage, must be in position by 9 p.m., Wednesday, 30th March.

BOXES.

All butter specially manufactured and prepared for exhibition purposes, must be packed in PLAIN STANDARD LOCAL BOXES (BRANDED BOXES NOT PERMITTED).

All exhibits for Classes 2 to 8 to be addressed to the Director, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., c/o. Waterside Cold Stores Pty., Ltd., 10 Point-st., Pyrmont, Sydney, and must be in cold store as stated in each class.

Exhibitors failing to observe this Regulation are liable to disqualification.

For purposes of identification a label, bearing the full name of the exhibitor (Factory) together with full particulars of the class for which the exhibit is intended, must be securely affixed to the lid of each box before it is wrapped in its protecting cover.

The surface of the butter must be impressed with the Australian Roller Brand.

An exhibitor who may desire to go through the exhibits with the judge, after judging day, shall make an appointment through the Steward-in-Chief or the Director.

Arrival and Departure of Exhibits.

Butter for classes as hereunder mentioned must be addressed to the Director, Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W., c/o. Waterside Cold Stores Pty., Ltd., 10 Point-st., Pyrmont, Sydney, and be delivered not later than the dates shown, viz.:

Storage of Export Butter.

All exhibits for storage will be placed in cool chamber and kept at a temperature not exceeding 20 degrees. The exhibits will be removed from Cold Store to Showground after judging.

Unclaimed Exhibits.

All exhibits unclaimed on Wednesday, 13th April, will be sent to an agent and sold; the proceeds, less expenses, will be forwarded to exhibitor.

MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR PRIZES.

(Dried Milk, Cheese, and Bacon Curer).

The most successful exhibitor prizes in this Section shall be determined as follows, viz. — Only exhibitors with three or more exhibits shall be considered for this prize. The total number of points awarded to each exhibit by the Judge shall be divided by the total number of entries made by the exhibitor and to the result obtained shall be added the following points, viz. — Three for each first prize, two for second, and one for third; the exhibitor gaining the highest result shall be the winner. Should two or more exhibitors gain an equal number of points, the Most Successful Exhibitor Prize will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the greatest number of first prizes. Should the points still be equal the number of second prizes, and if necessary the number of third prizes will be taken into account in determining the prize. In the case of a maker (Dried Milk, Cheese, and/or Bacon Curer) who exhibits in the names of two or more factories, each factory will be regarded as a separate and distinct exhibitor.

CLASS 1—CONTINUOUS GRADING CLASS FOR BUTTER (LOCAL CONSUMPTION)—Special Prizes, £40, viz.: First, £20; second, £12 10s.; third, £5; fourth, £2 10s. £5 or a cup or trophy will be presented to the respective buttermakers of the factories securing the first, second, third and fourth prizes. The factories shall nominate, on the certificate of entry, the recipients (buttermakers) of the cups or trophies.

A Bronze Medal will be awarded each factory gaining a box average of 93.5 per cent over the period of competition, provided that for any one month the average grading of the factory shall not be under choicest grade of 93 points.

CONDITIONS.

1. The competition is for salted or unsalted butter sold on the local market in N.S.W.
 2. The Grading Period will cover seven months, viz. — March and April, 1954, followed by the period October, 1954, to February, 1955, inclusive. From the consignments during the month of February, one box may be taken for exhibition at the Show.

3. Every factory competing must grade officially at least 85 per cent of its production as choicest quality.
 4. The official grading by the State Officers of all the registered choicest brands of factories entered for this competition will be taken each month for the full period and results worked out by taking the actual mean average in which the number of boxes in each consignment, together with the grading points, is taken into account.
 5. At least four gradings must be recorded each month including at least four churnings, representing at least two vats of cream in each grading during the period of the competition. A competitor who fails to comply with this condition will automatically become ineligible for the prizes.
 6. The grading points allotted by the State Graders will be taken for the full period and a box average established by dividing the total of the points allotted to each consignment by the total number of boxes graded, and the exhibits obtaining the highest box averages will be awarded the prizes.

ROYAL SPECIAL EXPORT BUTTER PRIZES.

CLASS 3 Butter, salted, 2 packages, not less than 56lb. each. Manufactured and packed ready for export. First, £10; second, £5; third, £2.

- (a) One box to be staged and judged at the Show, the other box to be forwarded to London and judged there. Points for both judgings, in Sydney and London, to be added and the prizes awarded to the factories obtaining the highest aggregate points, after points for consistency are taken into account.
- (b) Points for consistency in grading will be reconciled by deducting from the aggregate points obtained any points allotted by the judges under the standard of choicest—93 points, e.g., if a butter is awarded 92 points, one point is deducted from the aggregate.
- (c) Butter to contain a minimum of 15 per cent of water and not to contain any preservative other than salt.
- (d) Butter must be in plain standard local boxes (branded boxes not permitted). For purposes of identification each box to bear a label stating name of exhibitor and number of class to be competed for. Labels will be removed after boxes have been numbered and registered.
- (e) The butter will, after judging, be sold on factories account and returns sent to individual factories by the Society.
